

Report on STC on "Unnat Bharat Abhiyan"
organized at Mehr Chand Polytechnic College, Jalandhar (Punjab)
from 29th July to 2nd August, 2019 (Oplan No.RD-5)

A Short Term Course on "**Unnat Bharat Abhiyan**" was organized at Mehr Chand Polytechnic College, Jalandhar (Punjab) from 29th July to 2nd August, 2019 in collaboration with Hans Raj Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jalandhar (Punjab). There were 31 participants participated from Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh states. All the participants visited the organic farm developed by Pingalwara, Amritsar which was located at village jandiala guru. Sh. Rajbir Singh, Farm Manager, from Pingalwara, Amritsar described about the development made at the organic farm. He described the following techniques which is being used for organic farming:

1. Re-cycling and use of cow dung and urine of cows for composting
2. Preparation of bio-fertilizer
3. Inter -cropping and crop rotation
4. Fruits and vegetable production
5. Rearing of desi cows of "Shahiwal Breed".

It was unique model developed by Pingalwara which is working for integrated farming. The participants were also given field demonstration at village Seechewal. Sh. Tejinder Singh, Sarpanch shared his experiences of Integrated Village Development which was undertaken by him under the guidance of Sant Balbir Singh Seechewal. After the talk, he demonstrated the waste water treatment model developed in the village. It is an unique waste water treatment model developed by Shri Seechewal.

After this demonstration, we visited Nursery of Seechewal village. On the occasion of 550th Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Nanak Devji, it has planned to plant 5,50,000 plants in all over the Punjab state. About two lakh plants sapling have been distributed and planted at various parts of the Punjab through this Nursery. After this visit, all the participants were taken to Sultanpur Lodhi where Sant Balbir Singh Seechewal delivered a talk and interacted with all the participants on the issue of waste water treatment and cleaning the various rivers of India like Ganga. A video programme was screened by Sh. Tejinder Singh which demonstrated the initiatives taken by Sh. Seechewal for the revival of Kali Bain river which is emerging from Hoshiarpur. This initiative was started by Sant Balbir Singh Seechewal in year 2005. Later, he got a huge support from his followers and he got success in cleaning the river Kali Bain which has a lot of spiritual importance because Sri Guru Nanak Devji has taken bath in that river long time back.

This development was also appreciated by the then President of India Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam who visited Sultanpur Lodhi and village Seechewal during the year 2007-09. Sant Seechewal has got Padam Shri has become international figure and he has been invited by the various countries like United Kingdom and Canada.
