



Brief Report:

As part of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), a village survey was conducted in Belamam, Amadalavalasa Mandal to assess the socio-economic conditions and key challenges faced by the villagers. The demographic and livelihood analysis revealed that most villagers depend on agriculture and daily-wage labour, with limited alternative employment opportunities. In terms of education and literacy, while the village has a primary school, access to higher education is a challenge, and there is a need for vocational training programs. Healthcare and sanitation facilities are inadequate, with limited medical services and poor drainage systems affecting hygiene. The infrastructure and transportation situation requires improvement, as roads need maintenance and public transport is scarce. Water and electricity supply remains inconsistent, with frequent power cuts affecting daily activities. Agriculture and environment challenges include water scarcity, outdated farming techniques, and the need for sustainable agricultural practices. To address these issues, recommendations include improving road infrastructure, establishing digital learning centres, setting up mobile medical camps, ensuring better water supply, and promoting modern farming techniques. Overall, the survey highlights the need for targeted developmental interventions to enhance the quality of life in Belamam village.

Recommendations & Interventions:

- **Education:** Establish digital learning centers and vocational training programs.
- **Healthcare:** Set up mobile medical camps and improve awareness about health and hygiene.
- **Infrastructure:** Improve road conditions and expand public transport facilities.
- **Water & Sanitation:** Implement better drainage systems and provide clean drinking water solutions.
- **Agriculture:** Promote sustainable farming techniques and provide financial assistance to farmers.
