Objectives of Event:

- **To conduct a comprehensive household survey** in the adopted villages under Shinoli Gram panchayat and accurately collect socio-economic, demographic and developmental data.
- **To provide students with experiential learning exposure** by engaging them directly in rural community interactions and ground-level data collection.
- **To sensitize students about the living conditions, challenges and resource constraints** faced by Scheduled Tribe communities, particularly the Thakar Samaj.
- **To enhance students' understanding of participatory rural development**, government schemes, and community needs assessment.
- **To encourage students to actively contribute to community cleanliness and sanitation** through temple cleaning drives executed during the visit.
- **To motivate students to appreciate the value of minimal-resource living** and develop empathy, responsibility, and civic engagement.
- **To strengthen collaboration between the institute and rural communities** under the framework of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan for sustainable village development.

Summary of event

MKSSS's K B Joshi Institute of Information Technology is selected for Unnat Bharat Abhiyan in the academic year 2025-26. Five villages namely Kalewasti, Kanamchi Wadi, Malwadi, Maymbawadi and chinchechi wadi were adopted for the survey purpose. These villages belong to Shinoli Grampanchayat, Ambegaon Taluka District Pune. Survey and household form filling activity was planned from 08 to 11 December 2025. FY BCA & MCA (12) students were selected for the purpose. Out of 195 houses 141 were covered and all the information was filled in the form. The 99 percent community is scheduled Tribe specially Thakar Samaj. In the same period, two temple cleaning drives were executed and one small Jirenium Oil Extraction Unit was visited.

It was really a learning experience for the students. This will keep them motivated to survive with minimum resources. To get connected with the community technical activity will be planned in future and will be executed accordingly
