



“Meendum Manjappai” – Environmental Awareness World Record with 3,000 Students”

The Research and Development Department of Indira Ganesan Institutions, in association with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), successfully organized a World Record Environmental Awareness Programme titled “Meendum Manjappai” on 06.01.2026. The event was conducted in a grand and remarkable manner, creating a historic milestone for the institution.
