Infrastructure and Equipment Support for Rural Women

The Infrastructure and Equipment Support for Rural Women under Project Pragati was implemented on September 16, 2025 across Tikker Panchayat and Sanhol Panchayat of Solan District, Himachal Pradesh. The activity was organized by the Centre for Leadership Coaching, Shoolini University with the objective of enabling rural women to become production-ready by providing essential equipment and infrastructure support, thereby facilitating the practical application of skills acquired during earlier phases of coaching and training. Under Project Pragati, infrastructure and equipment support worth approximately ₹1.49 lakh was provided to strengthen participants' readiness for livelihood activities and to support production-related processes. This intervention effectively complemented the coaching, mentoring, and skill development components of the project, allowing participants to transition towards independent and sustainable livelihood initiatives. As a result of the activity, rural women demonstrated improved readiness for production, reduced dependence on external resources, increased confidence to initiate income-generating activities, and enhanced the overall sustainability and impact of the training and development program.
