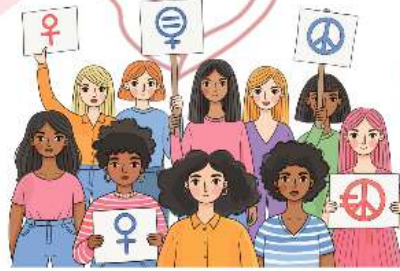




AIMT UBA CELL
