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Brief Report

The UBA Cell of Delhi Institute of Higher Education organized an outreach activity titled *“Workshop on Safe Digital Transactions with Decoding Online Frauds”* on 06 February 2026 at Tamolipur as part of the institution’s commitment to community service, awareness, and holistic development.

The activity was conducted both within a local school and in outdoor community spaces, witnessing active participation from students and villagers. An interactive approach was adopted, encouraging participants to share their experiences and ask questions. The workshop focused on creating awareness about digital safety and online frauds, highlighting safe online practices such as using strong passwords, not sharing OTPs with unknown individuals, and avoiding suspicious links.

Participants were also informed about common indicators to identify fraudulent links and callers. To reinforce learning, handouts containing digital safety tips were distributed, and information about helpline numbers for reporting digital frauds was shared.

The outreach activity was conducted successfully under the guidance of the faculty coordinator. Special efforts were made to reach and inform as many villagers as possible through both school-based and community interactions. Local students and children were encouraged to act as messengers of awareness by sharing the knowledge gained during the workshop with their parents, family members, and friends, thereby extending the impact of the initiative beyond the immediate participants.
