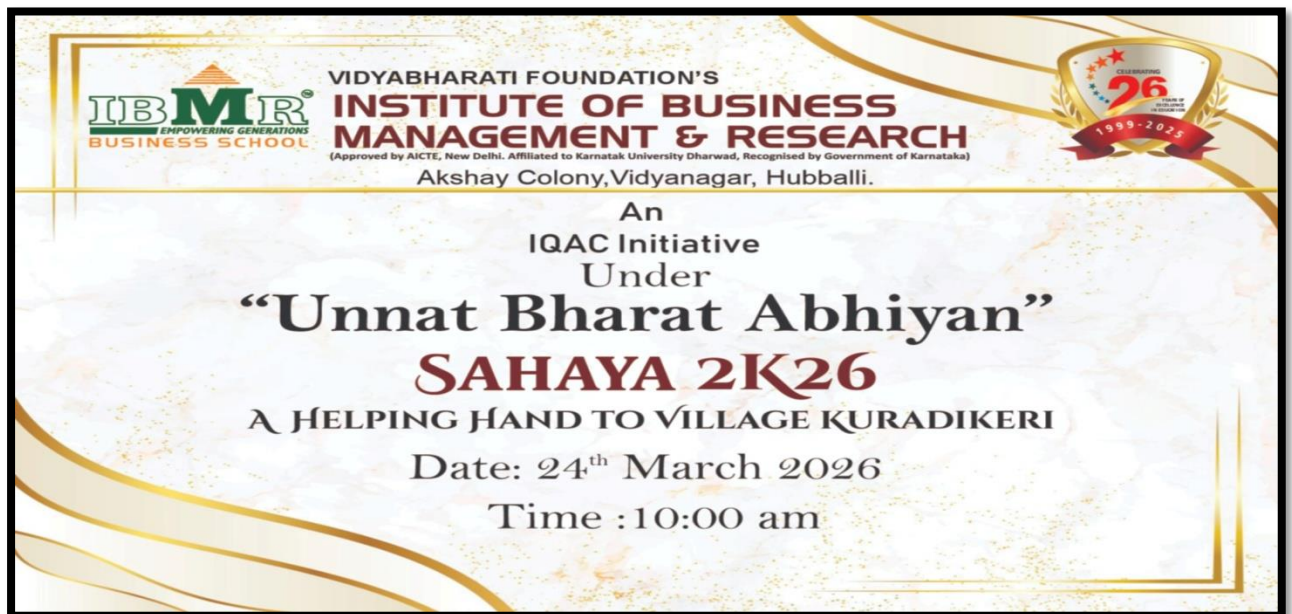

The villagers expressed heartfelt thanks to IBMR management, IQAC, and Unnath Bharath Abhiyaan for extending their support and care towards the rural community.



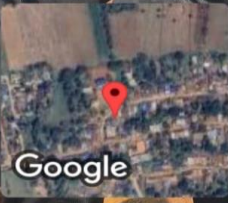
