

## Report of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Meeting

### Introduction

A meeting under the initiative of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan was conducted with the sarpanch representatives of three adopted villages:

- \* Sambhoi
- \* Vemar
- \* Suravada

The meeting commenced with the introduction of all team members which includes Dr. Hema Parikh Director of Community health services , Dr. Sayyad HOD of Dept. Of Community Medicine Dr. Mrunalika Dixit Co ordinator of project of Ummeed center of cerebral palsy Dr. Utsavi Oza coordinator of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan our MPW Ratilalbhai and Yogendrabhai and interns Hafza , Roshan , Rukhsar , Ajesha and Jinal to guide the team Dr. Mihir Parikh Campus Director and Dr. Ami Majmudar Deputy Supretendent was also present in the meeting . Each sarpanch briefly introduced their village and highlighted the major issues and developmental priorities of their community.

Following the introductions, Dr. Hema initiated the discussion regarding the vision and working approach of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan team. The sarpanchs were encouraged to openly discuss the priority areas where institutional support and collaborative work could benefit their villages.

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## Village-wise Discussion Points

### 1. Vemar Village

The sarpanch of Vemar village discussed several important concerns and developmental needs, including:

- \* Need for tree plantation and protective cages for plants.
- \* Requirement of awareness programs regarding the Homoeopathic system of medicine.
- \* Presence of malnutrition cases and concerns related to maternal health and nutrition.
- \* Need for installation of dustbins to improve village sanitation.
- \* Poor road infrastructure in certain areas where even two-wheelers cannot access properly.
- \* Risk and prevalence of vector-borne diseases requiring preventive awareness and health activities.

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### 2. Sambhoi Village

The sarpanch of Sambhoi village highlighted the following issues and proposals:

- \* Tree plantation initiative in a specifically identified area.
- \* Construction of a check dam for water harvesting purposes.
- \* Need for water tank facilities in the Navi Nagari area.
- \* High number of reported kidney stone cases in the village.
- \* Presence of patients suffering from hypertension (BP) and diabetes mellitus (DM).
- \* Concerns regarding Vitamin B12 and Vitamin D3 deficiencies among villagers.
- \* Proposal to establish a women's self-help group focused on preparation and sale of dairy products to encourage women empowerment and livelihood generation.

### 3. Suravada Village

The sarpanch of Suravada village discussed the following priorities:

- \* Requirement of a water tank facility.
- \* Need for proper regularization and strengthening of self-help groups.
- \* Widespread issue of addiction in the village community, requiring guidance and awareness programs.
- \* Need for regular OPD visits and healthcare services.
- \* Due to addiction related to MAVA chewing, there is a significant requirement for dental check-up camps and oral health awareness activities.

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### Conclusion

The meeting served as an important platform for interaction between the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan team and village representatives. The discussion provided valuable insights into the healthcare, sanitation, nutrition, infrastructure, environmental, and social challenges faced by the adopted villages.

The sarpanchs actively participated and expressed their willingness to collaborate with the institution for the betterment of their communities. The meeting concluded with a commitment from the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan team to prioritize feasible interventions, plan community-based activities, and work in coordination with village leadership to address the identified issues systematically and sustainably.
