REPORT ON ADOLESCENT HEALTH SCREENING

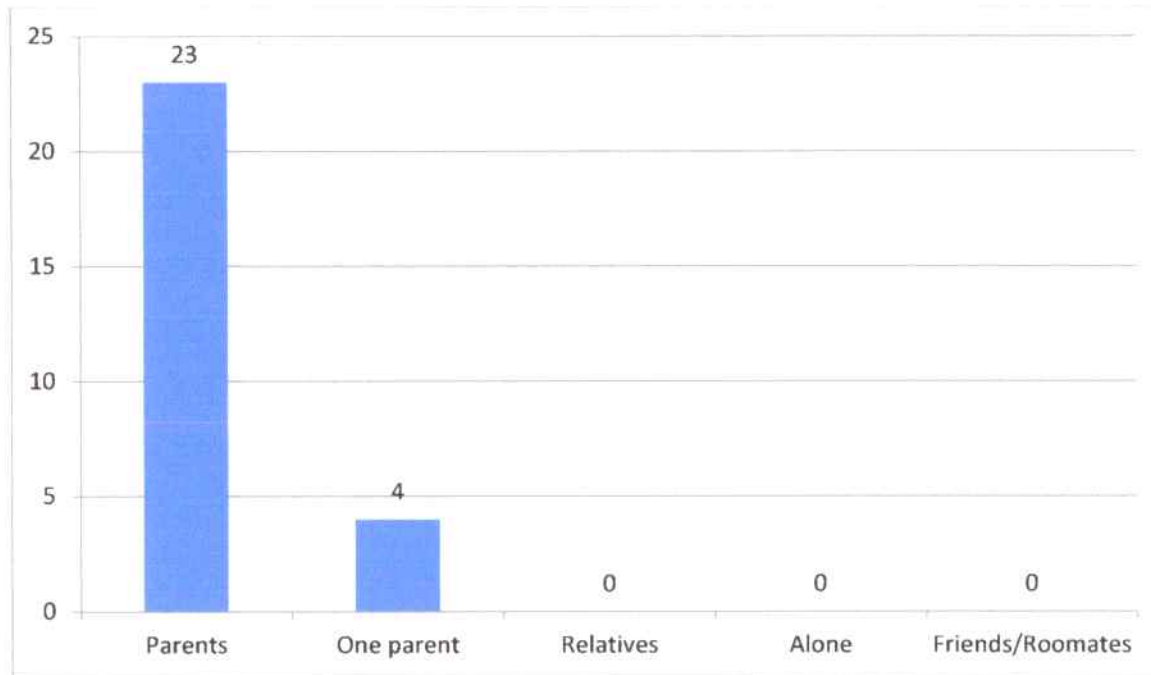

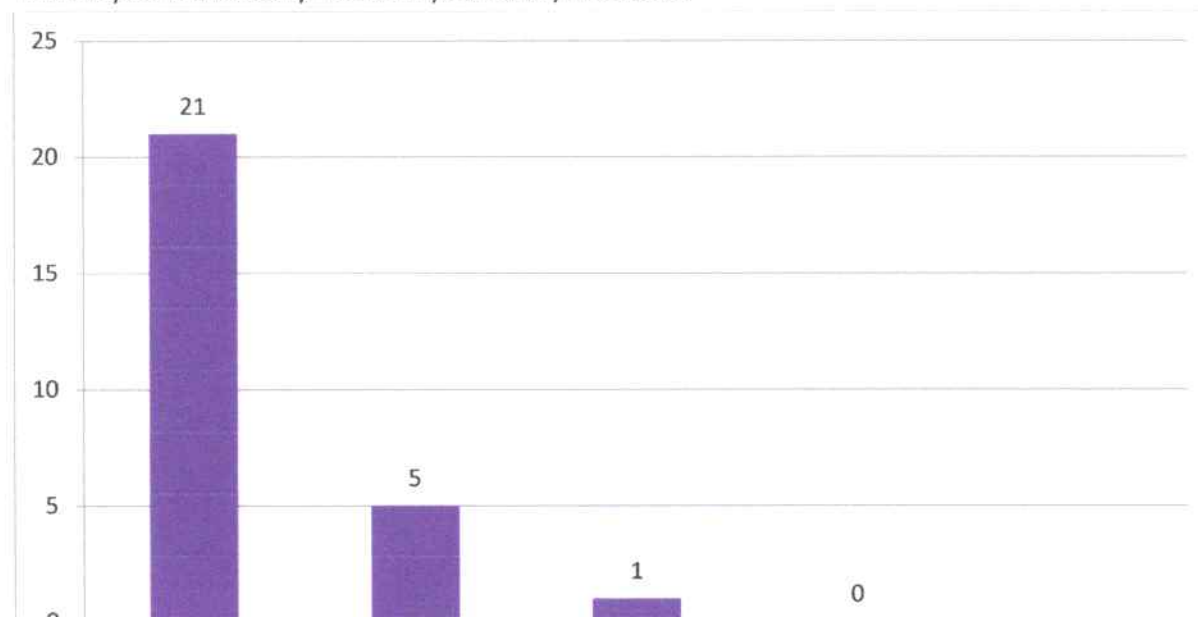

- To provide adolescent counseling.

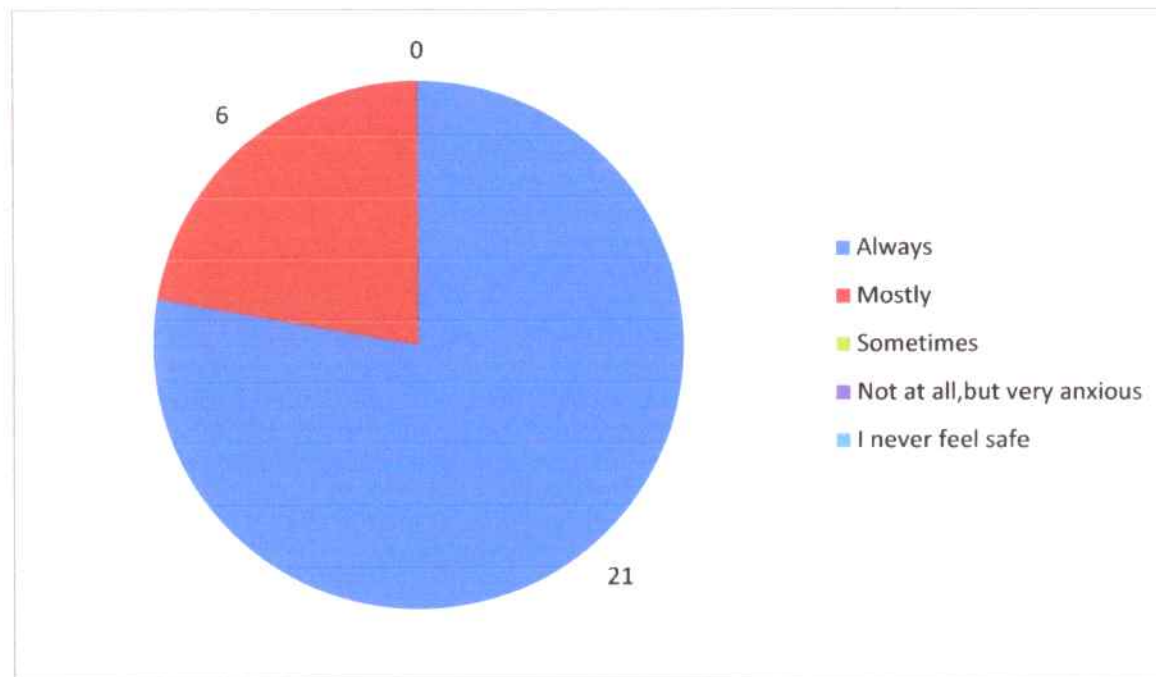

2) What is your relationship like with your family members?

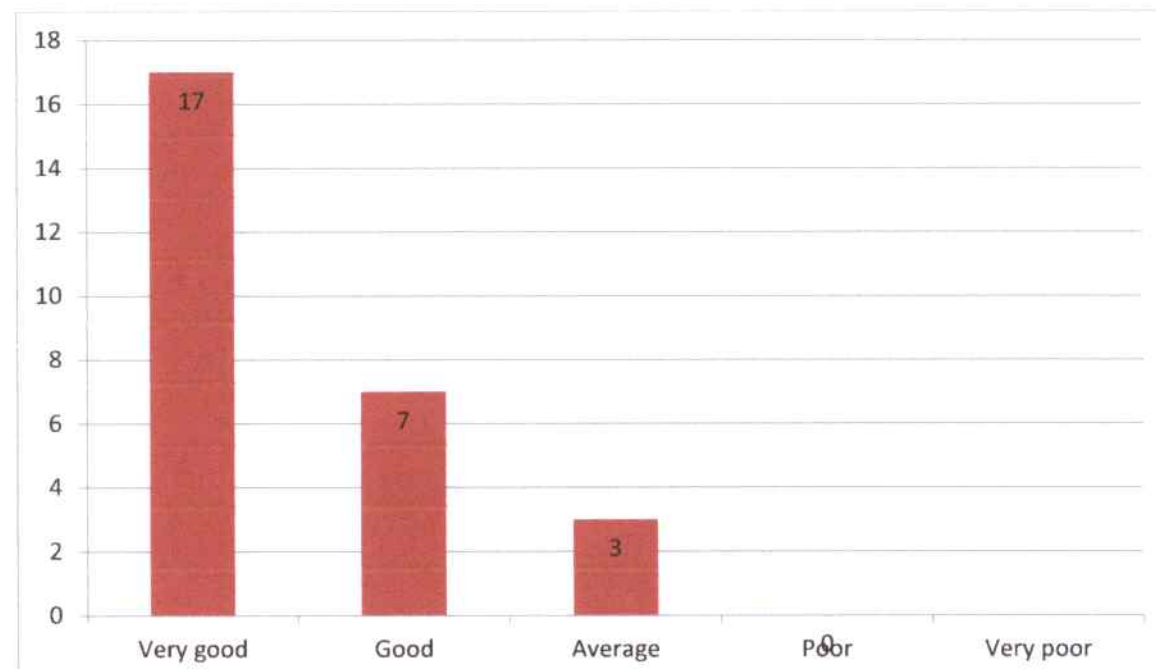

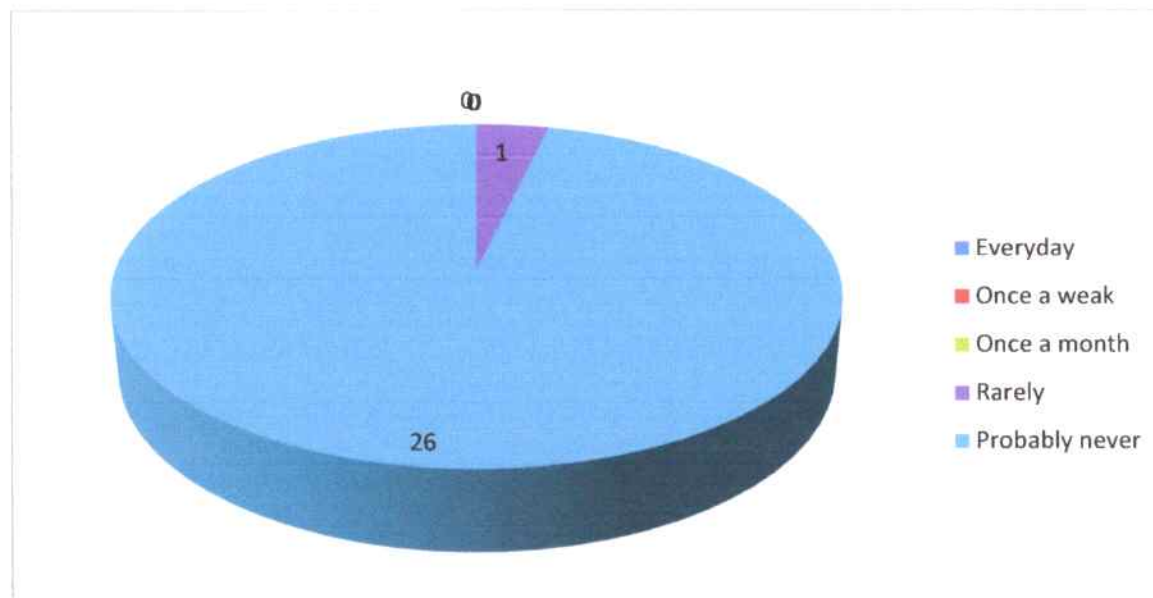

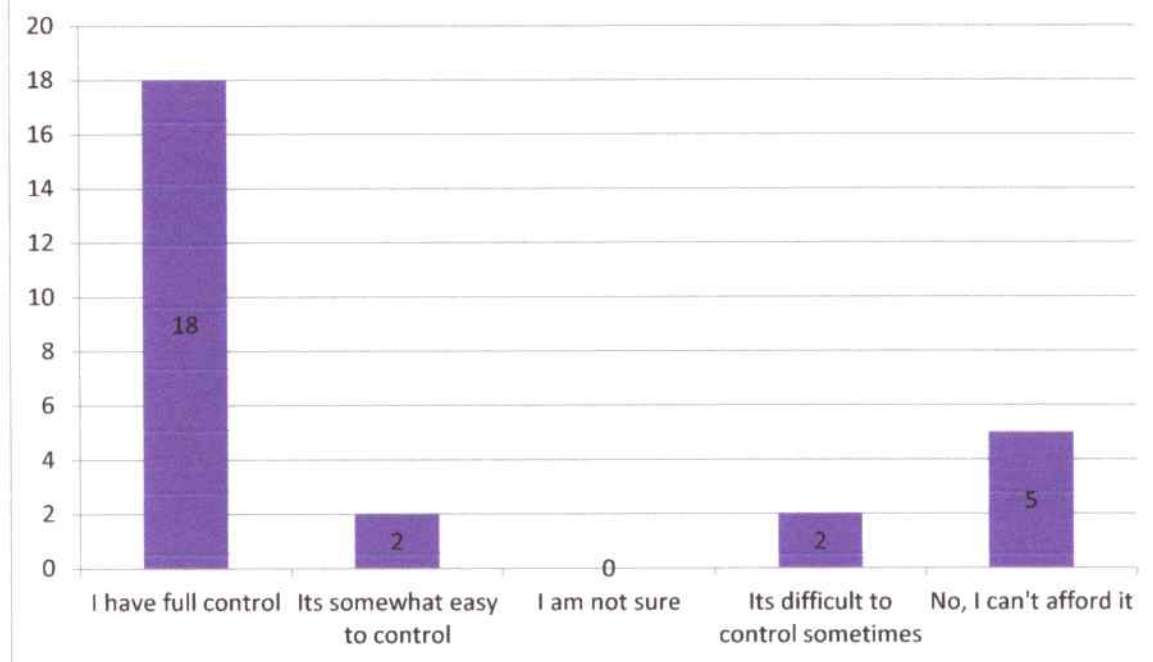

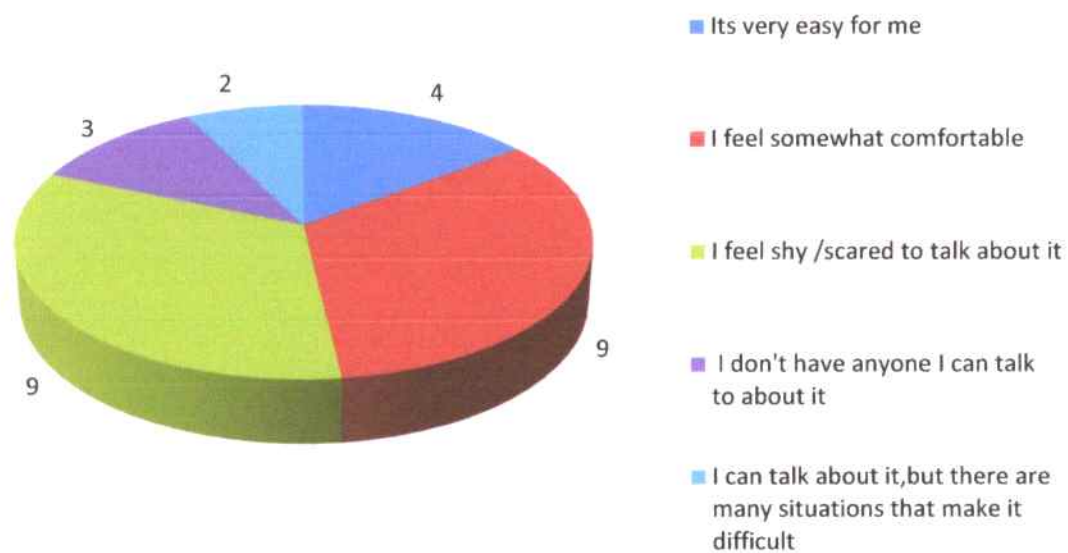
10) How often do you use alcohol or drugs?



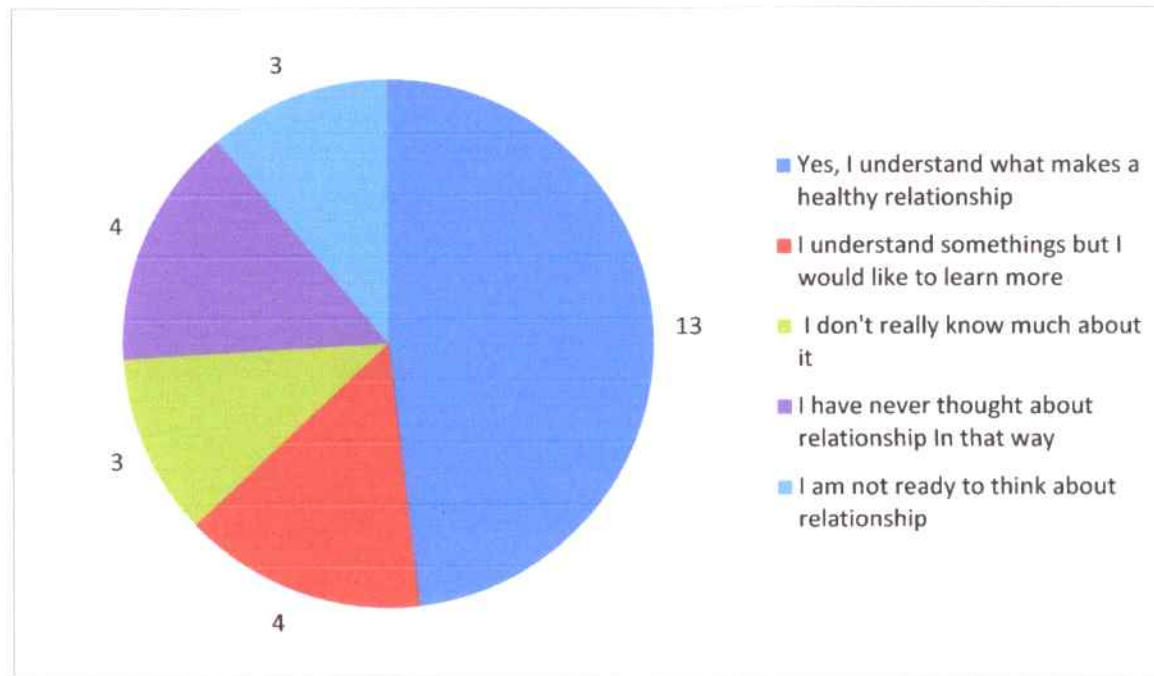

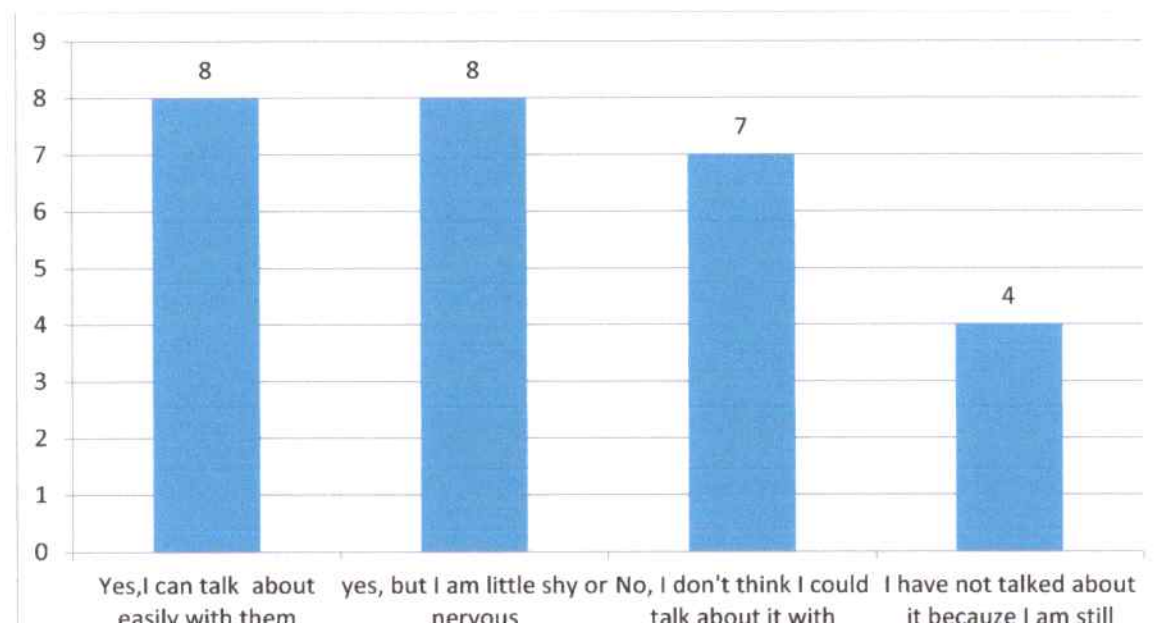
12) Is it easy for you to talk about sexual health matters?

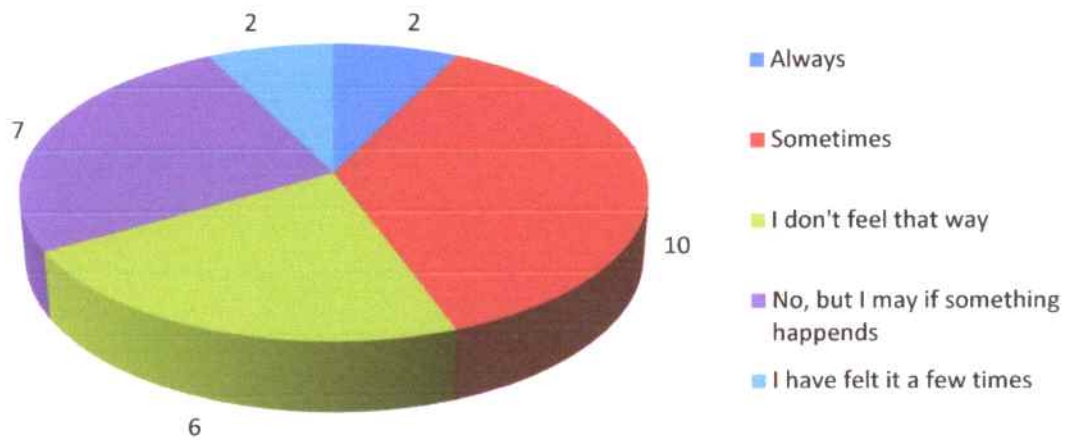


13) Do you feel you have enough information about how to form healthy relationship?

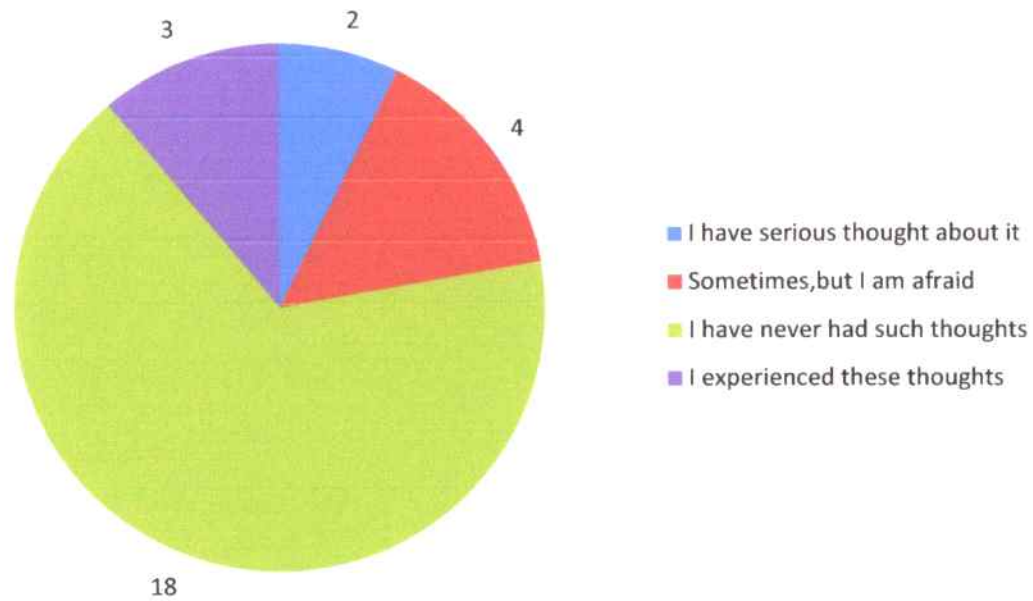


14) Do you feel comfortable talking about your sexual orientation with your family or friends?

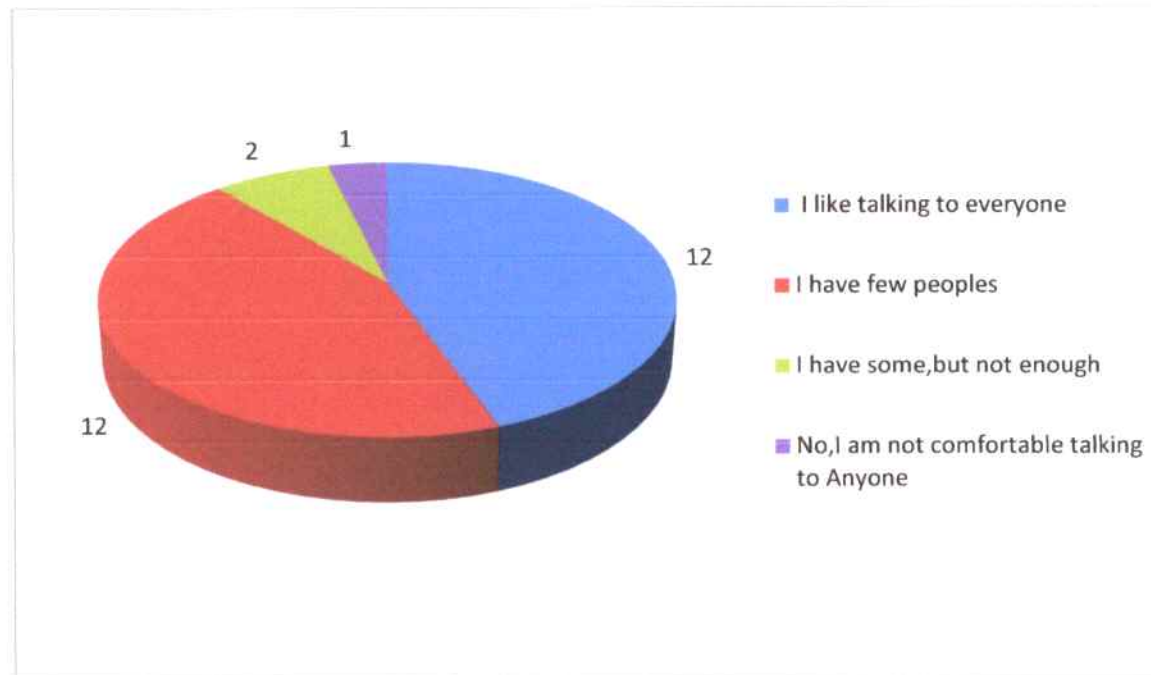
