An anganwadi is a type of rural child care centre in India. They were started by the Indian government in 1975 as part of integrated child development services program to combat child hunger and malnutrition.

ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT IN ANGANWADI

- Registration of ANC mothers at 3 months
- Registration of PNC and breastfeeding mothers post-delivery.
- Registration of children from the age of 6 months to 3 years
- Registration of children from the age of 3 years to 6 years for pre-school education.
- Registration of adolescent girls from the age group of 11 years to 18 years with the help of ASHA workers.
- Hemoglobin, weight is assessed for adolescent girls as well as register is maintained and medication are given if necessary.
- Deworming of children is done once in every 6 months and record is maintained.
- Supplementary nutrition diet week and breast-feeding week is celebrated once in a year
- Survey of the area is done and ASHA visits five houses daily.
