

Report on NEP Awareness Program

Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)

Introduction

Under the initiative of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, an awareness program on the National Education Policy (NEP 2020) was organized in the adopted village through a skit (nukkad natak). The main aim of the activity was to spread awareness among villagers about the new education system, its benefits, and its impact on students' future.

Objectives of the Program
