Malini Kishor Sanghavi Homoeopathic Medical College established a dedicated **Book Bank Initiative** at the primary and secondary school in its adopted village, Koliyad.

- **Resource Curation:** Academic textbooks, reference guides, and storybooks were cataloged and installed within a centralized space at Koliyad Village School.
- **Systematic Access:** A structured borrowing framework was established to allow students to consult and borrow resources throughout the academic term.
- **Institutional Impact:** Fulfills institutional social responsibility goals under UBA while directly improving material access for rural youth.
