


UBA (Unnat Bharat Abhiyan) a flagship program by Ministry of Education (MoE),
GOI - successful completion of SEG project by St. Pauls College of Pharmacy.

St. Pauls College of Pharmacy, a premier pharmacy institution recognized as UBA Participating Institute(PI) under MoE GOI from Telangana region in 2020. Since then the Institute has been undertaking adoption of five villages i.e., Manchal, Tippaiguda, Lingampalle, Dadpally, and Chittapur under Manchal Mandal, Lingampalle taluk. As a part of UBA program, the institute has taken stewardship to survey the villages & households to understand the problems at village level during 2021 for six consecutive months with approved seed fund of Rs. 50,000/-. The short comings were noted and SEG project was applied in 2022. Dr. M.Kiranmayi , UBA coordinator of the institution has received a seed fund of Rs. 1,00,000/- for the SEG project titled as " Pilot scale up for cultivation of Black rice and millets " in Manchal village. (Application No. UBA/10/0049/C-25962). The project was accomplished successfully in Manchal village under the project investigator Dr. M. Kiranmayi with the support of Govt. Panchayat Secretaries, Health care workers and Village people. The participating Institute is thankful to UBA program under MoE, GOI for creating platform and up taking programs related to capacity building of villages by which Mahatma Gandhi's dream to be fulfilled soon.
