
Our college received the fund of Rs.50,000 under the application of Unnath Bharath Abhiyan project on 31.03.2022. No further correspondence through email happened after that. We tried to contact the officials through the available emails and phone numbers but no further information was provided on how to proceed further. We were able to contact Mr. Akhil GS, Regional Program Coordinator, Unnath Bharath Abhiyan and the further instructions were provided.

Activity No. 1

The Women's Cell of our College aims at all round development of girl students. With the intention of equipping students with multiple skills, Women's Cell in association with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan project of our College, has purchased two sewing machines with a total cost of Rs.13400. The functioning of the new skill training center was inaugurated by College Principal Prof. Lally K. Cyriac on 20th May 2022 at 2 pm. College Vice Principal Dr. Stephen Mathew, Women Cell Coordinators Dr. Jisha George, Ms. Bibi Joseph, Ms.Asha Raju, Women Cell Joint Secretary Miss. Anjali Rajan, teachers and students from various departments were present in the inaugural ceremony.

Activity No. 2

An orientation session for the Unnath Bharath Abhiyan project for our college was held on 5th November 2022, 11.00 am via Google Meet platform. The resource person was Mr. Akhil GS, Regional Program Coordinator, Unnath Bharath Abhiyan. The orientation was held for members of the Women's cell and NSS of the college. Principal Investigator, Ms. Asha Raju coordinated the event. Various programs to be organized as part of the project were explained. The meeting concluded around 11.30 am.



Activity No. 2

The Village Surveys to be conducted were initiated. Students participants of the women's cell and NSS of the college were identified through Google forms, based on their locations of residence and instructed to conduct the house surveys. The process is ongoing in Uzhavoor, Veliyannoor, Kurichithanam, Mulakulam and Njeezhoor villages even though the University exams and summer vacation delayed the process in between. Currently the survey forms are being consolidated.

Activity No. 3

A one day training on Organic Farming was conducted on 13th August, 2022 at 10:30am at the greenhouse facility of our college in association with the Department of Zoology of our college. Interested students were given hands-on training in organic farming and related practices. Students were trained on mixing of the soil, manure collection from vermin compost units, pot filling and planting of saplings. Dr. Sincy Joseph and Ms. Asha Raju from the department gave guidance to the students. Capt. Jais Kurian provided his expertise on the propagation and maintenance of Adenium plants. Students were highly motivated to continue the practice of organic farming at their homes. The group dispersed after lunch together at the college canteen.









Activity No. 4

Women's Cell and National Service Scheme (NSS) in association with Unnat Bharath Abhiyan of this college, in hands with K. R Narayanan Multi speciality hospital has organized a free medical check-up for the benefit of staff of this college on 22nd August 2022 in Room no :107. The team arrived at 11.am.
