## **BACKGROUND**

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) is a flagship program of the Indian government aimed at promoting rural development by harnessing the knowledge and resources available within the higher education institutions of the country. The program was launched in 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 as a part of the Ministry of Human Resource Development's efforts to bridge the rural-urban divide and uplift the quality of life in rural India. Here is a closer look at the background and need for Unnat Bharat Abhiyan:

- Presently, around 70% of the population in India lives in rural areas engaged in an agrarian economy with agriculture and allied sector employing 51% of the total workforce but accounting for only 17% of the country's GDP. There are huge developmental disconnects between the rural and urban sectors such as inequity in health, education, incomes and basic amenities as well as employment opportunities- all causing great discontent and large-scale migration to urban areas. The imperatives of sustainable development which are being felt more and more acutely all over the world also demand eco-friendly development of the villages and creation of appropriate employment opportunities locally. Increasing urbanization is neither sustainable nor desirable.
- So far, our higher educational institutions have largely been oriented to cater to the mainstream industrial sector and, barring a few exceptions, have hardly contributed directly to the development of the rural sector. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) has been conceived to explore the potential of higher educational institutions to enrich rural India.
- The conceptualization of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan started with the initiative of a group of dedicated faculty members of Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi working in the area of rural development and appropriate technologies. The concept was nurtured through wide consultation with the representatives of a number of technical institutions, Rural Technology Action Group (RuTAG) coordinators, voluntary organizations and government agencies, actively involved in rural development work, during a National workshop held at IIT Delhi in September 2014. The program was formally launched by the Ministry Human Resource Development (MHRD) on 11 November 2014.
- IIT Delhi has been designated to act as the National Coordinating Institute for the UBA and several apex institutions (IITs, IISc, IIMS, NITS, IIIT's, CUs) which already have adequate experience, know-how and infrastructural set-up for rural development activities are being identified as regional coordinating institutions to nucleate the process and to take responsibility of nurturing and coordinating other institutions in their vicinity and thus act as nodal centres for the Abhiyan.

To involve the reputed higher educational institutions (technical/non-technical/public/private) of the country in the process of indigenous development of self-sufficient and sustainable village clusters.

- Reorienting the academic curricula and research programs in higher educational institutions to make them more in alignment with the local needs to bring in holistic development.

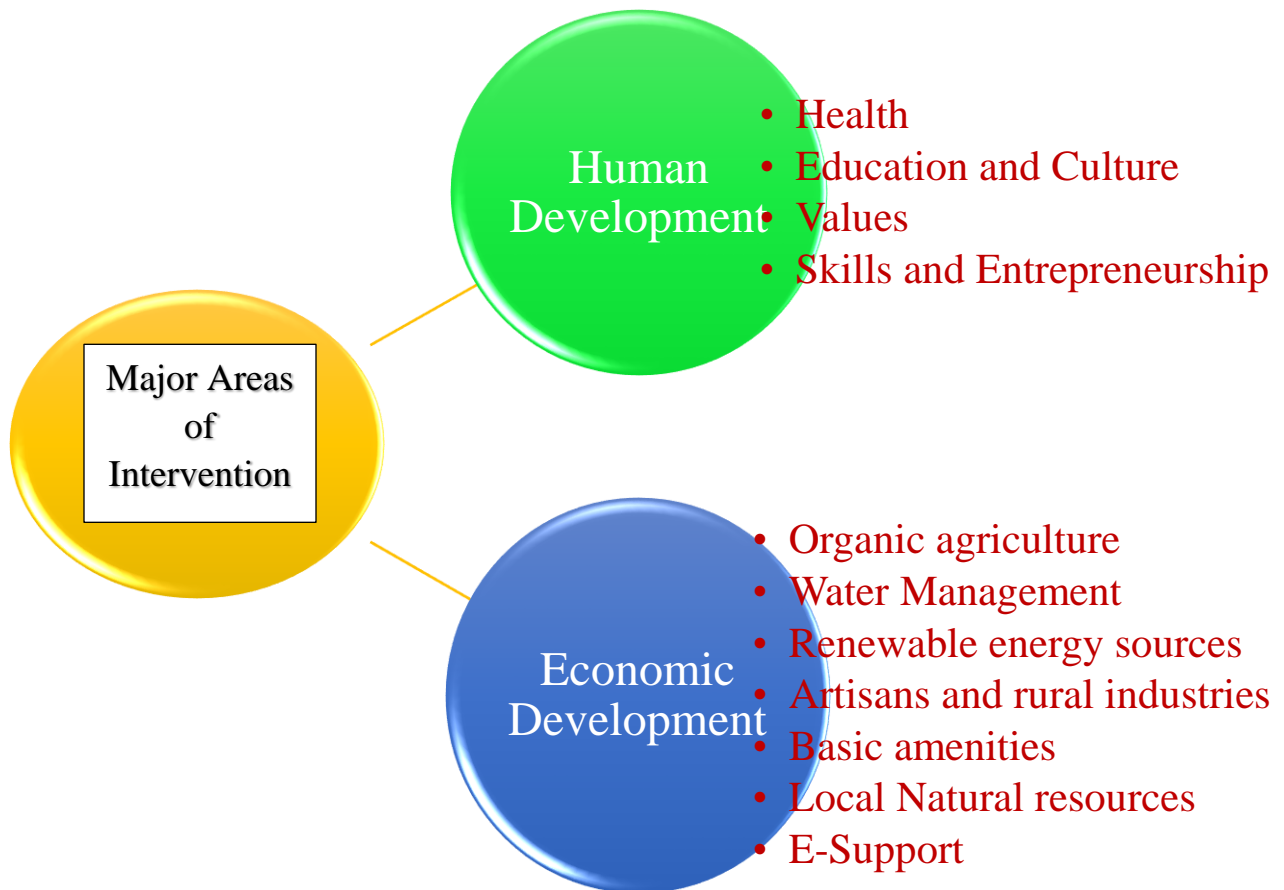

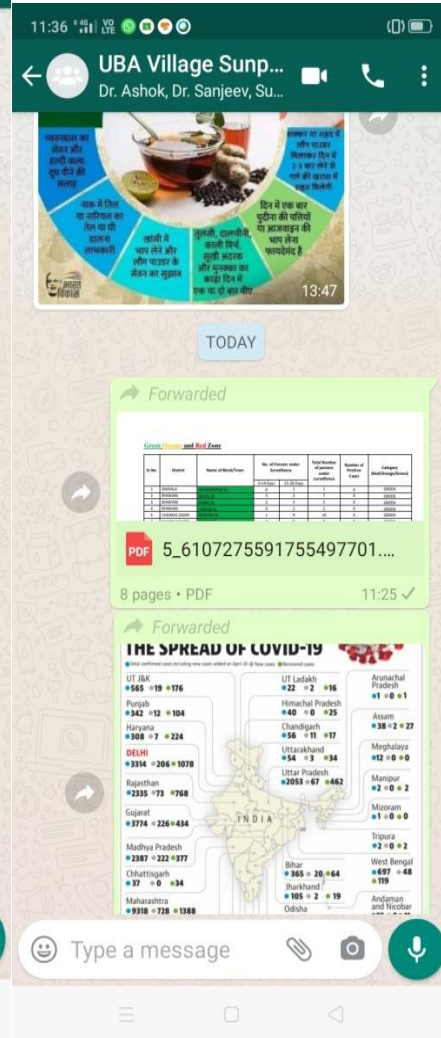
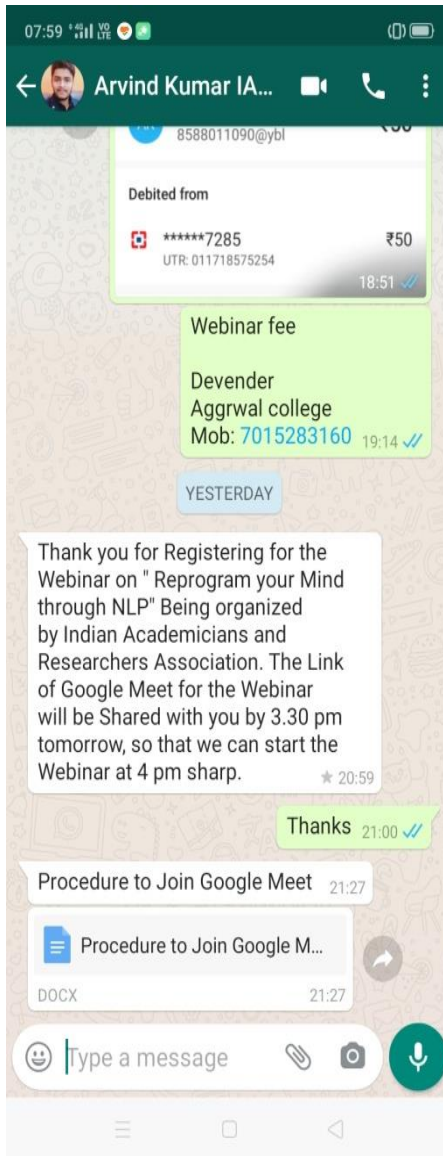


### **3. COVID Awareness Campaign 2020**

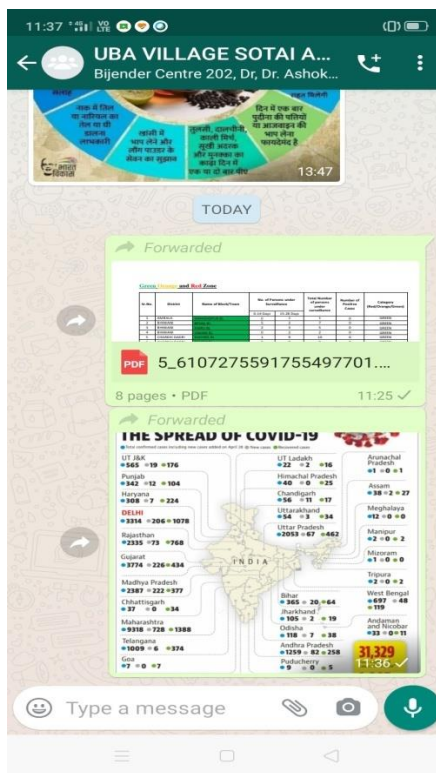

- 3. Information about new technologies developed in research labs:** A number of techniques that has been developed by CSIR research laboratories keeping in view the climatic conditions all over India were shared with villagers in the adopted villages. On 24/09/2020, the college UBA team met the Sarpanch and other village persons about these technologies. Some of the villagers showed keen interest in these new techniques and agreed that utilizing new techniques and their experience would not only improve their agricultural product but also increase employment and resources.



- 4. Mask Distribution Campaign:** Under the auspices of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell, a dedicated team of volunteers from Aggarwal College Ballabgarh embarked on a meaningful mission to visit the labor site in their adopted village, Chandawali. Led by their teacher in charge, Sh. Subhash, these enthusiastic volunteers conducted an extensive door-to-door awareness campaign aimed at educating the villagers on the essential precautions to protect themselves from COVID-19. During this outreach initiative, the volunteers not only disseminated valuable information about COVID-19 safety measures but also distributed masks and gloves to the villagers. This act served as a tangible symbol of their commitment to ensuring the well-being and safety of the community in the face of the ongoing pandemic.



- 5. Household Survey:** In early 2020, our unit embarked on the journey of adopting a village partnered with our college. The survey of four villages took place in October 2020. This marked the commencement of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) campaign, which aimed to engage with the adopted villages with the active participation of UBA volunteers from Aggarwal College Ballabgarh. In each of these villages, a thorough household survey was conducted, covering a minimum of 250 households per village. To maintain consistency and accuracy in data



collection, we employed standardized Baseline Household Survey forms, meticulously crafted by the UBA, to assess the living conditions and needs of the villagers. The collected data from all the surveyed villages has been meticulously uploaded onto the UBA Portal for further analysis and action.



**6. Village Survey:** After the household survey, we convened a crucial meeting with the village Sarpanch and the esteemed members of the village Panchayat. The primary objective of this meeting was to gather comprehensive information concerning various aspects of village life, including road infrastructure, available transportation options, land usage, forest resources, horticultural activities, village infrastructure, and the status of basic amenities.

During this highly productive meeting, the villagers engaged in a constructive dialogue, addressing the significant issues that had been identified during the household survey. This collaborative effort resulted in the compilation of a consolidated list detailing the major challenges and concerns facing the village community, setting the stage for targeted interventions and improvements.

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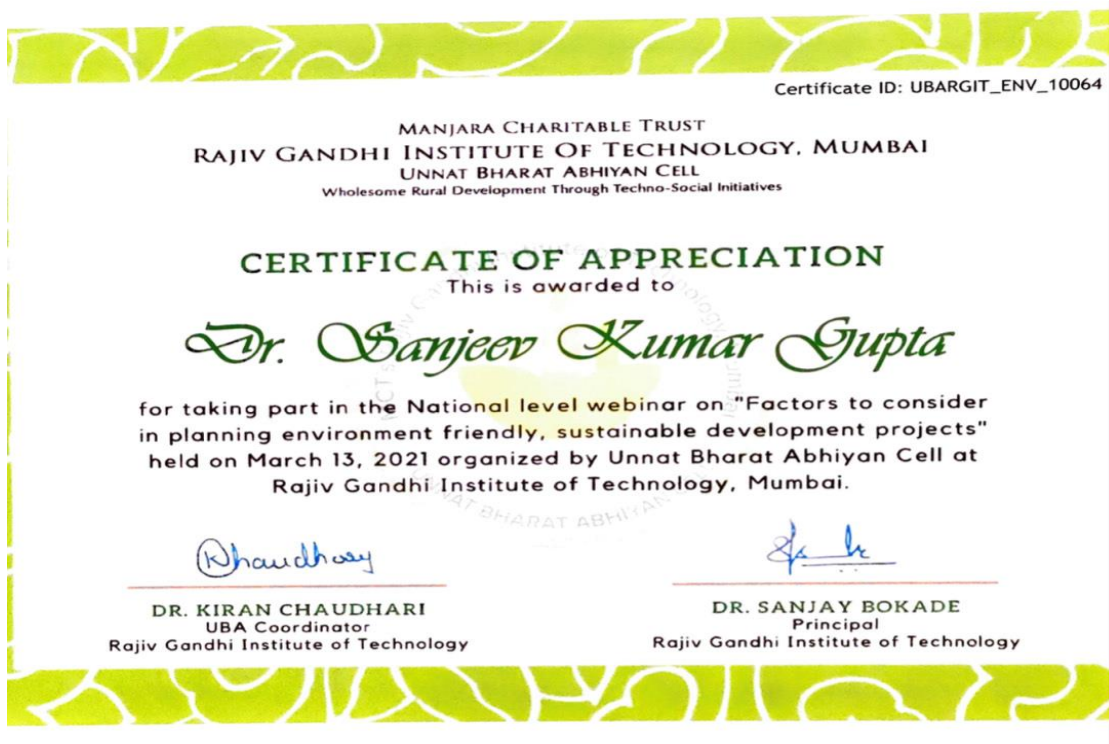

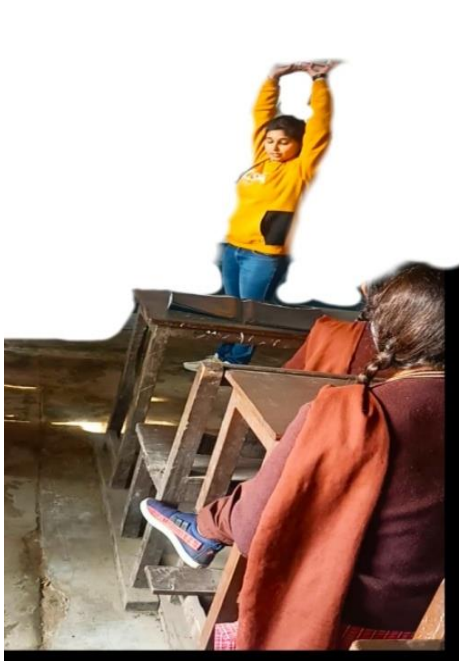
