3. Added the field data in the online portal of UBA in the month of January, 2023



Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell Survey

Date : From 14/12/2022 to 28/02/2023

The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell of Panigaon OPD College organised the socio-economic survey of the five adopted villages in the month of December from 14/12/22 to 24/12/22 under the co-ordinatorship of Ms Gyanashree Kotoky, Assistant Professor, Panigaon OPD College. From each village a sample of 30 household was taken. The total survey was over 150 household for which the village survey and household survey questionnaires were provided by the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Official Portal. The data of the same epwas uploaded in the month of January and February, 2023 in the official portal of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. The survey was carried with the help of faculty members- Annunay Kumar, J.P. Bhuyan and Dhurba Jyoti Dutta. The student volunteers supported in the survey and in the online data upioad process.

The five adopted villages are:

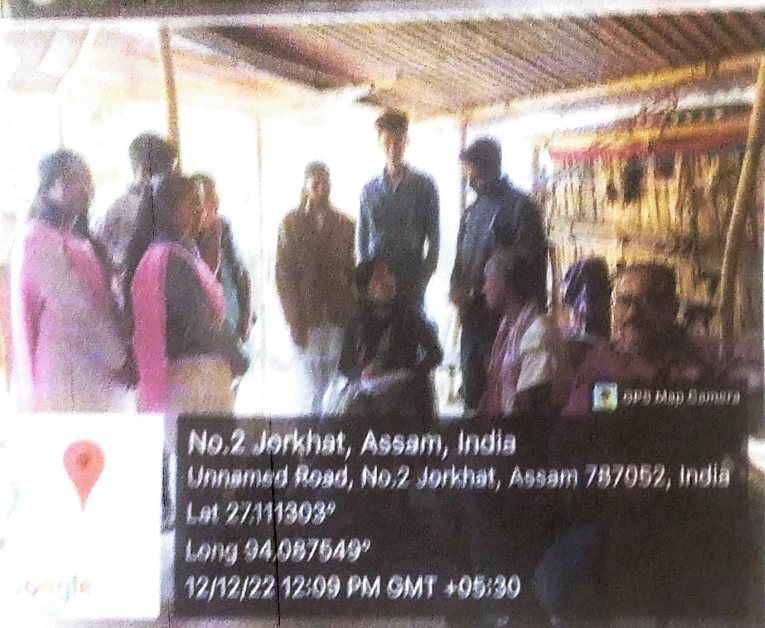
1. Duliamaut
