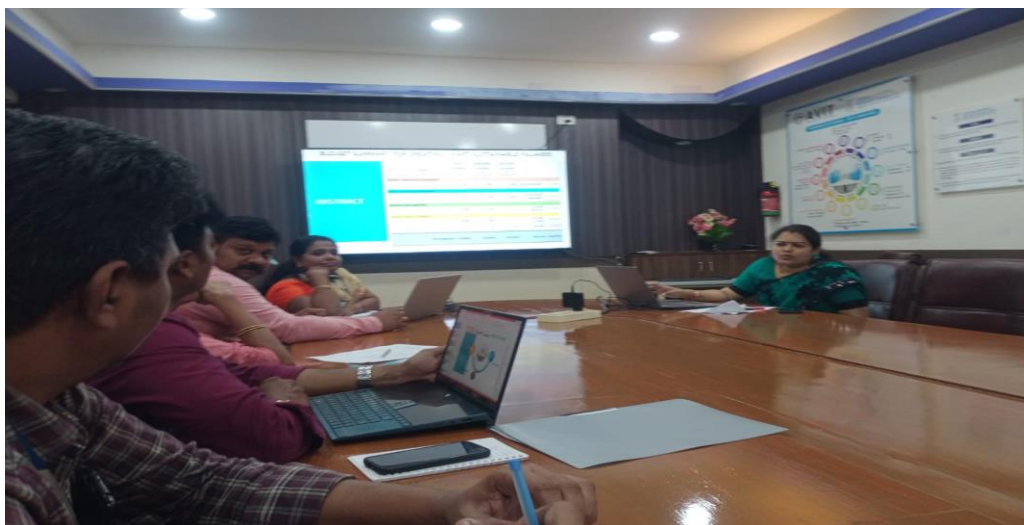


The Department of Mechanical Engineering and the ISR cell of AVIT, in association with the Rotary Club of Madras, organized a one-day skill development workshop on the Latest Troubleshooting Technologies Using Bosch State-of-the-Art Equipment for individuals who have chosen the profession of automobile mechanics in the 5 villages adopted under the UBA program. This workshop was initiated in response to a request from the villagers and further discussions were held to plan its implementation. Subsequently, the Rotary Club generously agreed to sponsor tool kits and T-shirts for the participants, which would greatly assist them in their troubleshooting work after successfully completing the training workshop.





The village coordinators were tasked by the AVIT ISR cell to identify the areas in their village that truly needed sustainable development and smart village development. The coordinators of the UBA village came with minimal criteria and worked relentlessly for it. The ISR programme director, Dr. S.P. Sangeetha, and the UBA coordinators were then consulted, and with the assistance of the Madras Rotary Club, a few suggestions were made to assist them.



To start with Rotary club of Madras initiated WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) project in schools of three of the adopted village . The Inauguration of WASH project was held on 12th Oct 2023. The chief guests of the Ceremony were Rtn. Dr.Anuradha Ganesan, Director of community services, RCM & Vice President, VMRF –DU, Rtn. Ravi Sundaresan, President, Rotary Club of Madras and the program was presided in the presence of village president, ward councils, BEO, Rotary presidents, AVIT ISR cell members and villagers.
