As per constitution of India and Panchyati Raaj Act, Shahdara village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is elected representative of village.

Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 5.41 % of total population in Shahdara village. The village Shahdara currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population.

In Acchepur village out of total population, 452 were engaged in work activities. 91.37 % of workers describe their work as Main Work (Employment or Earning more than 6 Months) while 8.63 % were involved in Marginal activity providing livelihood for less than 6 months. Of 452 workers engaged in Main Work, 269 were cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 39 were Agricultural labourer.

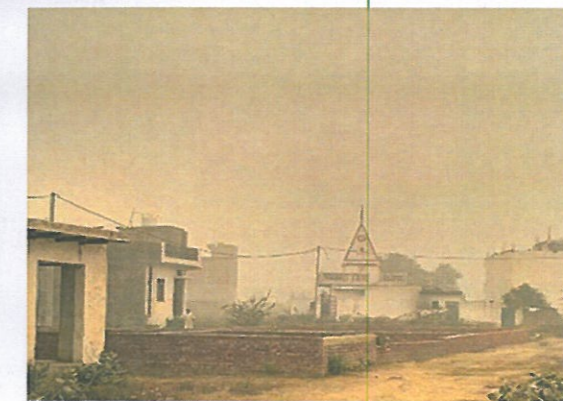

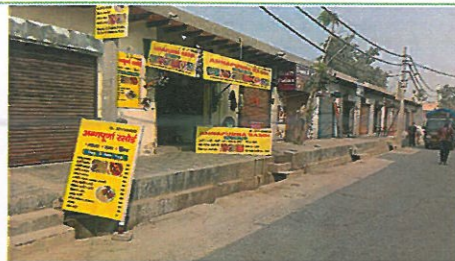

ISSUES IN THE VILLAGE

1. ROADS IN SOME PARTS ARE IN VERY BAD CONDITION
2. SEWAGE IS A MAJOR PROBLEM AND CAUSE OF DISEASES
3. DUE TO THE HOUSEHOLD WASTE IS ON THE STREET THE CONDITIONS ARE VERY UNHYGIENIC ON THE STREET.
4. THERE IS NO HOSPITAL IN THE VILLAGE.
5. VERY LESS COMMERCIAL AREAS INSIDE THE VILLAGE.
6. THERE IS NO CBSE AFFILIATED SCHOOL IN THE VILLAGE .
7. ILLEGAL EXPANSION OF THE HOUSES MAKING THE STREETS CLOSELY PACKED .
8. STRAY ANIMALS ARE A PROBLEM THERE
9. THE OPEN AREAS ARE NOT MAINTAINED AND NOT GREEN

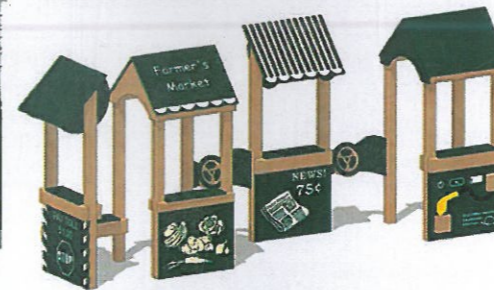
THE COMMERCIAL AREA SHOULD BE INCREASED AND SHOULD BE CONTINUOUS

RECOMMENDATIONS

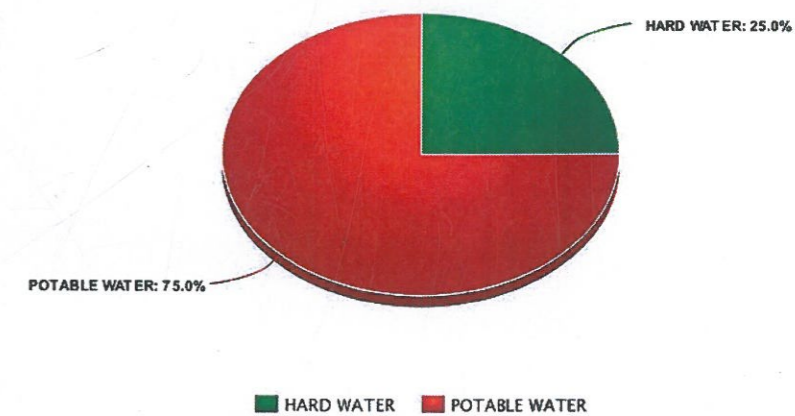
Solutions

6. ILLEGAL STRUCTURES SHOULD BE DESTROYED
7. THE OPEN AREAS SHOULD BE TRANSFORMED INTO PARKS AND PLAYING AREAS FOR THE KIDS.

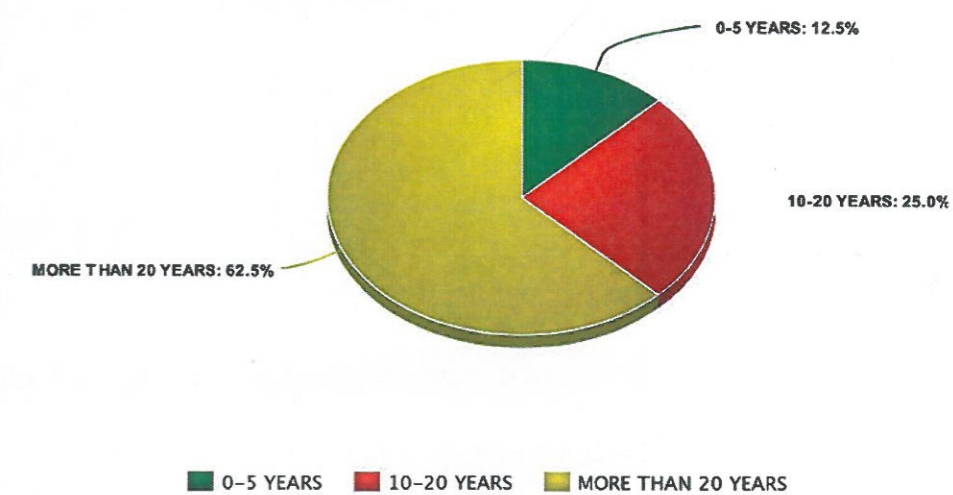
