

Quarterly Report: October 2023 - December 2023

1. Two Days Stakeholders Consultative Workshop

- Event Name: Two days stakeholders' consultative workshop on "Handling support to village Panchayats on Preparation and Implementation on Village Panchayat Development Plan (VPDP)."
- Date: 25/11/2023 and 26/11/2023
- **Details:** Our UBA coordinator, Mr. D. Muralidharan, actively participated in the workshop organized by the State Institute of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (SIRDPR), Maraimalainagar, Chennai. The workshop aimed to enhance the support provided to village Panchayats in the preparation and implementation of Village Panchayat Development Plans (VPDP).



2. Village Household Survey: Nanthambakkam and Naduveerapattu


One notable event during this period was the Village Household Survey conducted on 28th November 2023 in Nanthambakkam and Naduveerapattu villages.

- Survey Date: 28/11/2023
- **Objective:** The primary aim of the Village Household Survey was to gather comprehensive data on the socio-economic status, living conditions, and specific needs of households in Nanthambakkam and Naduveerapattu villages. The survey is a critical component of our commitment to evidence-based decision-making and targeted development initiatives.
- Execution: A dedicated team, comprising UBA coordinators, volunteers, and community representatives, undertook the survey in both Nanthambakkam and Naduveerapattu. The survey covered a range of parameters, including but not limited to:

- Demographics
- Education and literacy levels
- Healthcare access
- Sanitation and hygiene
- Economic activities
- Infrastructure needs
- **Methodology:** The survey was conducted through a combination of interviews, observations, and the utilization of the recently developed UBA App. This approach ensured a systematic and efficient collection of data.
- **Community Engagement:** Prior to the survey, the team engaged with the local communities to explain the purpose of the survey, address any concerns, and encourage active participation. Community involvement was integral to the success of the survey.
- Data Compilation: The collected data is currently undergoing thorough compilation and analysis to extract meaningful insights. This process will aid in identifying specific areas of focus and priority for development interventions.
- Feedback and Validation: The findings will be shared with the respective communities for validation and additional insights, ensuring the inclusivity and accuracy of the data.
- Strategic Planning: The survey results will inform the development of strategic plans and initiatives tailored to address the identified needs and challenges in Nanthambakkam and Naduveerapattu villages.

3. Two Days Workshop cum Training

- Event Name: Two days workshop cum training on "Communities outreach programme by HEIs of India through No cost Low cost activities."
- **Date:** 03/11/2023 and 04/11/2023
- Details: Mr. D.Muralidharan and Mr.A.Ponshanmugakumar, our UBA coordinators, actively participated in a workshop and training organized by the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (NIRDPR), Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India, Hyderabad. The focus was on community outreach programs through cost-effective activities by Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs).

- Details: A noteworthy milestone was achieved on 12th November 2023, as Tharunraj (III year CSBS), Vishal, and Krishna Kumar (both from III year CSE), under the guidance of Mr. Gopinath, Assistant Professor, CSE, successfully developed the UBA App. This application is designed for the purpose of conducting the UBA Village Household Survey. The demo of the UBA App was presented to the review committee members and the UBA Scope Team.
