
The villagers openly talked about the problems they have been facing in their day to day life. The main issues are listed below, along with likely technical fixes.

5	Doklongia Habi Gaon	i) Drinking water	Till PHE department provides pure drinking water to the villagers, we advised them to use low cost water filter made of sand and charcoal to avoid health issue, as ground water used by the villagers contains excess amount of iron. We are planning to help them in this regard.
		ii) Drainage of waste water	A proper drainage system for outlet of waste water may be provided.
		iii) Wild elephant attack	Solar electric fencing/ bio- fencing may be the solution. Also, solar powered street light may help avoiding elephant attack to some extent.






