

Report of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Selection of the cluster: Anand Niketan College of Agriculture, Warora Dist: Chandrapur (Maharashtra) is one of the participating institutes under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA). As being the professional and higher educational institute/college works in development programmes assigned by the state and central government. Our college had adopted five villages (viz. Yewati, Khemjai, Salori, Borda and Chinora) of Warora block/cluster in Chandrapur district. The cluster was selected with permission of the district collector. The villages were selected on the basis of similarities in various factors such as social and economical activities, geographical resemblances, cropping pattern, soil types, irrigation sources, technological awareness, etc.



Awareness generation and social mobilization: All the adopted villages in the cluster are informed regarding Unnat Bharat Abhiyan programme. Through this programme, farmers in the villages get aware about the importance and role of participating institute for development of villages. They are advised to adopt the new technologies developed by the research institutes of the country and how these adoptions will helpful in growth of village development.
