Summary Report on Peddapalli Village Visit

As a part of the course Social Innovation-I, Centre for Innovation and Social Transformation has organized a village visit to first year CSD students on 12-06-2023 to identify the criteria and constraints of their respective problem statements. As a part of this visit, the students interacted with different community people and validated their problem statements. The following problem statements are associated with the Peddapalli village.

1. The agricultural crops are being ruined by wild boars because they either destroy the plants or consume them. Also, they may cause damage to crops when they are wallowing and rooted, which causes damage to plant roots and creates holes in the soil.

All the students interacted with the different community and identified the criteria and constraints of their respective problem statements and why the problem is important to solve. The students identified the following criteria and constraints

Criteria:

1. Provide wire fences
2. Use natural resources instead of mechanical or chemical protective practices
3. Use electronic repellants

Constraints:

1. They are expensive
