Under the Auspices guidance of Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research Institute, A Sanitation Camp was conducted on 27.02.2024 at Siruvakkam village from 9.00 Am to 12.00 noon on behalf of Department of Community Medicine in collaboration with National Service Scheme and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. This camp was conducted as a part of action achieving LSDG goal- 2 for which we are committed too. A Cleaning campaign was initiated by Dr.K.Shankar - Head of the department and NSS Co-coordinator, Dr. K. R Pandiyan- Associate professor and UBA coordinator and the event was graced by the presence of headmaster of primary Government school, Siruvakkam village and village head of Siruvakkam. The event was organized by Dr.Sakthivel Senior resident and Postgraduates. A total 9 CRMIs and 30 Second Year MBBS Students from the department of community medicine participated in the campaign. Primary School, Integrated child development services Centre (ICDS), Nearby water bodies and streets in Siruvakkam village were cleaned in the campaign. The rags and wraps were segregated into Bio-degradable and non Bio-degradable wastes. A walkathon was held to raise awareness with inspiring theme related slogans (Need of Sanitation and Hygiene) by Faculties, PGs, CRMIs and Second Year MBBS Students of the department. The rally attracted public attention in helping to spread the message to a wider audience. The importance of environmental sanitation was also explained.
