4. SURVEY REPORT CONDUCTED AT KOLATHUR AND CHETTIPUNIYAM ADOPTED VILLAGE UNDER UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN IN CONNECTION WITH MY INDIA PROJECT

In connection with the My India Project for II year B.Sc. Students (Maths, Physics and Chemistry), they were taken outside to UBA Adopted villages Kolathur and Chettipuniyam to do a survey project under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. Under the guidance of Dr.V.Thirumurugan associate director campus life and Nodal Officer of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan-SRMIST along with 31 students, we started the trip from SRMIST Kattankulathur on 11/02/2023 at 8.50 AM. Before starting the trip all the members took pledge against plastic usage. Thirty one students (Maths-6, Physics-10, Chemistry-15), two staffs each from Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry departments, Mr. N.S. Sridhar from Estate office and Mrs. Anju (Intern from School of Public Health)were present in the field visit. We had our snacks inside the bus .We reached the Kolathur village by 10.30 AM. We met the village VAO and we started our house hold survey work. Students were divided into 10 groups containing two girls and one boy. They went to all the streets of the village in great enthusiasm and they took the house hold survey. Each group covered more than 12 houses, and total of 94 house hold survey were completed in the morning session. Meena Parvathy Sankar, staff from Maths department took the village survey from the VAO. All completed their work within 1.00 PM. We had our lunch in the nearby temple. We started our survey work in the afternoon in Anbu nagar Village, Chettipuniyam. In that village we visited the houses of irular community people and the people welcomed us with great enthusiasm and the students took the house hold survey. Our Associate Director also accompanied us to the village. We took photos with the people. We completed the work by 4.PM. In the evening session, students covered about 74 houses in the house hold survey. The forms were handed over to Mrs. Anju (Intern from School of Public Health) at the end, the students and the staff were provided with nice snacks and we all returned to the college by 5.15 PM.













5. MEDICAL CAMP REPORT – February 2023

SRM Medical College Hospital & Research Centre under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan SRMIST has conducted free medical camp for Irular Community peoples of Anbu Nagar from Chettipuniyam adopted village on 18-02-2023 Saturday. Camp was conducted at the Kanniyamman temple located in the village which is easily accessible for the village peoples .Camp started by morning 9:30 This camp is totally team work which consist of medical and health professionals from various departments of SRM hospital .This General medical camp comprise of Optometry with general eve checkup and those who need special attention and care were referred to the department of ophthalmology other than that Pediatrics, General Medicine, Dermatology Checkup were carried out. Totally 110 people undergone general health checkup. All are treated with free consultation, medication, diagnosis. Patients who need further and regular checkup and treatments were referred to SRM general hospital provided with free treatment card. Free food is being given when coming for treatment in hospital. This regular camping will improve the health status of the village members and very helpful for the early detection, diagnosis and also the treatment or therapeutic procedures. People who needs medical care were referred to the respective departments and go through detailed evaluation and recommended for the treatment procedures. By 1:30 we have covered almost all the households of the village and people got benefitted with the camp and showed their gratitude towards the doctors and health professionals.

The Science Exhibition by students of 6th – 9th standard was inaugurated by Mr. M.Kalyana Sundaram, Tahsildar, Kundrathur Block, Mrs.Vasanthi Sambasivam, President, Nattarsanpattu and Dr.B.Samuel Jacob, UBA-SRMIST village coordinator.

This camp is totally team work which consist of medical and health professionals from various departments of SRM hospital .Totally 18 team members, This General medical camp comprise of Optometry with general eye checkup and those who need special attention and care were referred to the department of ophthalmology, Audio logical evaluation done by using pure tone audiometry and general checkup done for the hearing sensitivity and those who are showed less hearing sensitivity referred to the Department of Audiology other than that Pediatrics, General Medicine, Dermatology Checkup were carried out. Totally 139 people undergone general health checkup 19 male, 50 females, 28 male child and 42 female child. All are treated with free consultation, medication, diagnosis. Patients who need further and regular checkup and treatments were referred to SRM general hospital provided with free treatment card. Free food is being given when coming for treatment in hospital. This regular camping will improve the health status of the village members and very helpful for the early detection, diagnosis and also the treatment or therapeutic procedures. People who needs medical care were referred to the respective departments and go through detailed evaluation and recommended for the treatment procedures. 22. TRANSFORMATION OF FLORAL WASTE INTO VALUE-ADDED PRODUCTS: A SUSTAINABLE APPROACH TOWARD WASTE MANAGEMENT

Project was done by Dr.S.Vishali, Associate Professor, Department of Chemical Engineering – SRMIST. Project mainly focuses on solid waste management. Municipal solid waste contains a considerable amount of biodegradable waste, with a significant amount of garbage being floral waste from temples. The stack holders were trained directly to collect and segregate the floral waste from nearby temples and halls. They were also trained to convert waste to products with simple technology. Withoutmuch technological support, effortlessly, it was converted into soaps, dhoop, incensesticks, and so on. The products obtained from the small-scale industries can be sold at reasonable price in the temple premises, thus making the stack holders an entrepreneur and enhancing the rural women's financial status.

The floral residues were converted into organic manure, thus helping in sustainable agriculture. The organic manures can be used in the garden or fields toachieve ecofriendly agricultural products. Finally, a closed-loop sustainable approachwas developed to extract the hidden treasure from the floral waste and organic manure.

The separated floral petals were shade dried and powdered using a kitchen blender. These base raw materials, like powdered rose and Tulsi, were stored in therefrigerator. It was converted into value-added products like soap, incense sticks anddhoops in the laboratory. The number of ingredients required was optimized.



These ideas of converting discarded flowers into value-added products and the floral refuse into compost were trained in the Women's self-help group of Chettipuniyam village. Around 20 + rural participated in the training program and learned the process methodologies. The ingredients and necessary equipment required for product making and compost making were given to them.











PROJECT IMPACT

Environmental Impact

- Approximately 500 kg of temple waste was collected and converted into value-added products and manure during the project tenure.
- Conducted Outreach activity on "RURAL SELF-EMPLOYMENT TRAINING FROM WASTE TO WEALTH" to the Women Self-Help group of Chettipuniyam village
- Conducted a training program on converting Floral refuse into manure for the Housekeeping workers of Yoga HAYAGRIVAR Temple, Chettipuniyam.
- Ingredients and equipment used for the making of value-added products were given to the Women Self-Help group of Chettipuniyam village.
- Two Compost bins were installed in the Yoga Hayagrivar Temple premises in Chettipuniyam.

Socio-Economical Impact

- Rural women and physically challenged were involved in all the stages of operation, viz., collection, segregation, drying, value-added product making, converting residues into organic manures and so on.
- Training women/differently-abled people in making products from floral waste developed the self-employment opportunity and the circular economy.
- Enhancement of rural women's financial independence
- Raising their life standard through self-employment opportunities

Salient Features

- Much skills and educational qualifications are not mandatory
- The existence of simple technology involved in the above-said methods enabled the participation of rural women in this proposed project.
- Finally, this research idea would bring the closed loop sustainable solution for managing temple waste and a way to rural empowerment.

33. MASSIVE SEED NURTURING EVENT

CommuniTree, based out of Chennai created a man-made forest on government land on an open state reserve after having an agreement between the government officials. Hafiz Khan said, "Till now, CommuniTree has planted trees and created man-made forests at around 110 acres of land at 28 locations in Chennai and Bangalore. Other peoples also became part of it as a volunteer to take care of the plants and trees and keep the target of at least conserving 80%-90% of plants out of the entire plant and saplings sown." Hafiz said, "Humans are enemies of nature, on a path from where the human walks the plants never grow on that path again. At CommuniTree we organise vast camps to develop man-made forests. My organization has come forward to raise funds. The two major companies are Hero Motor Corp and The Times of India. There are many more such companies who also join their hands. With their help and support, CommuniTree has planted 5.6 lakh trees. The organization also creates butterfly parks in residential societies. It performs some activities at schools such as growing food forests with children and educating them about the benefits of trees and how to take care of them." CommuniTree founded by Hafiz Khan in 2018 has so far planted numerous trees and created man-made forests at around 110 acres of land at 28 locations in Chennai and Bengaluru. Starting with a vision of saving the environment by building a better and greener tomorrow by planting saplings, this organization has created manmade forests and helps conserve the environment by increasing the green cover.

Place: Government High School, Nattarsanpattu Date: 08.09.2023, 10.30 AM










42. WORLD STUDENTS DAY - 2023






49. Desk Bench Donation – 2023
