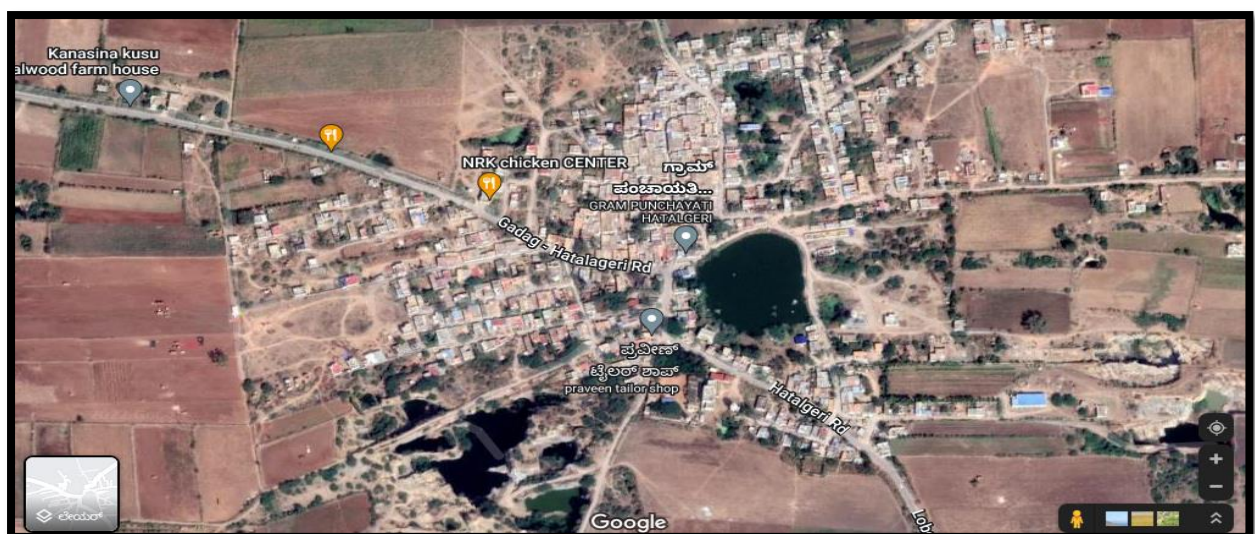

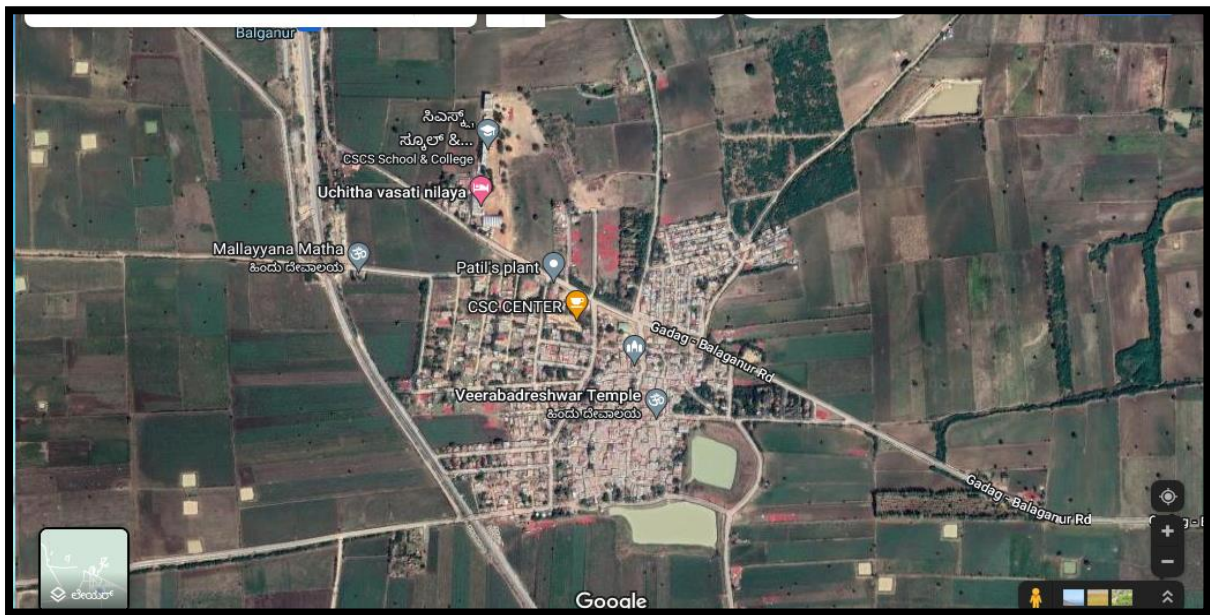

health workers are available in the village. In case of emergency, local people have to take the patient to the nearest hospital in Gadag which is already crowded and overburdened with the patients.

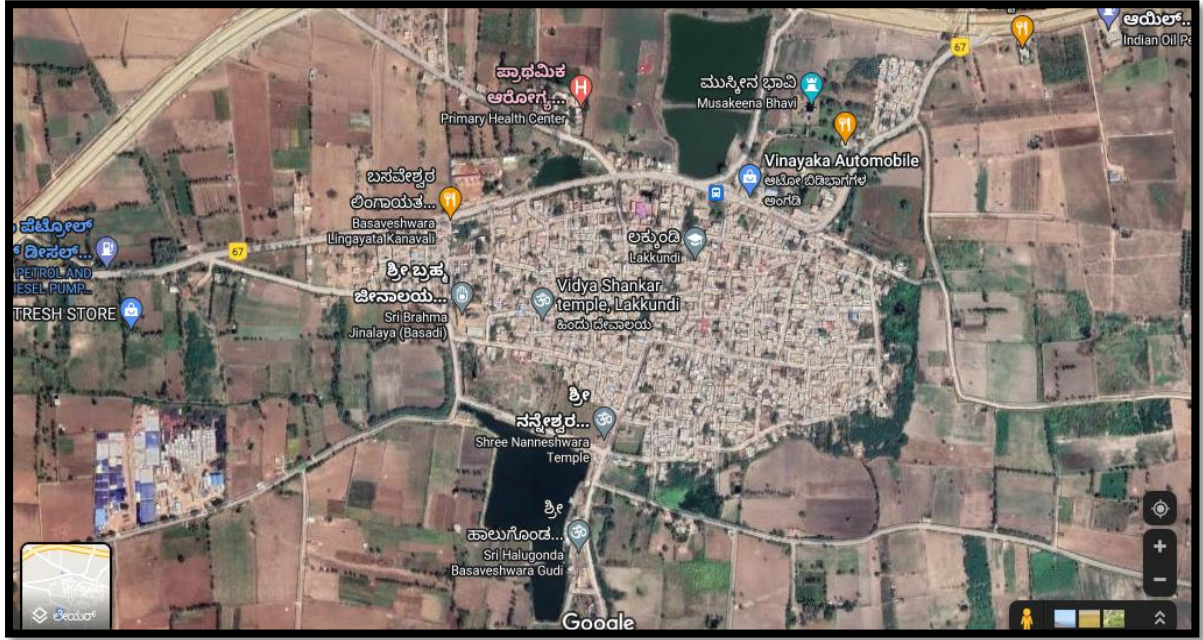

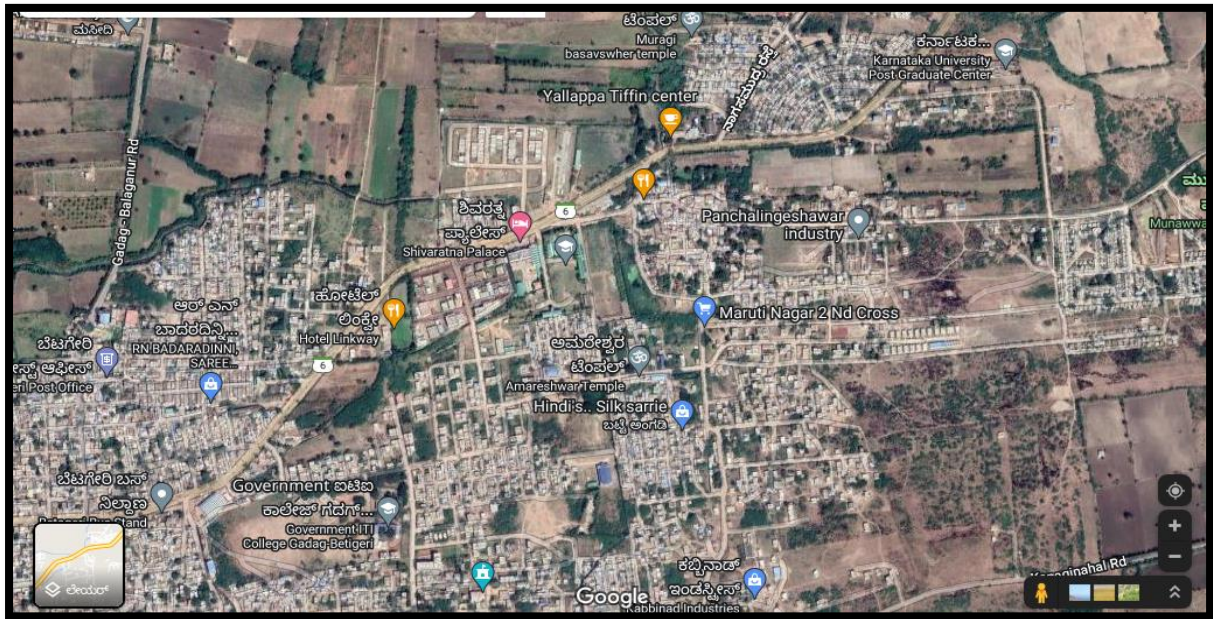
