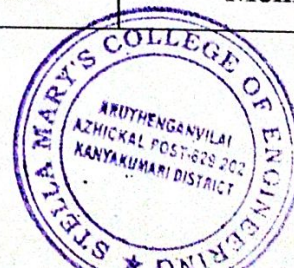

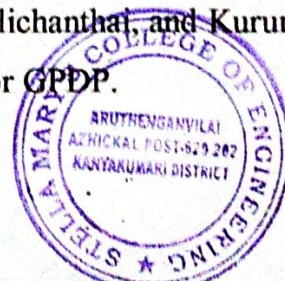

UBA of our college got the permission from Muttom, Vellichanthai, and Kurunthancode gram panchayats to implement following Low cost activities for GPDP.

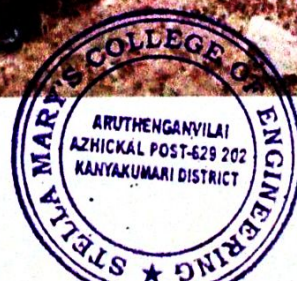

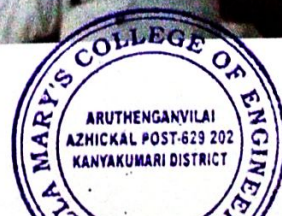
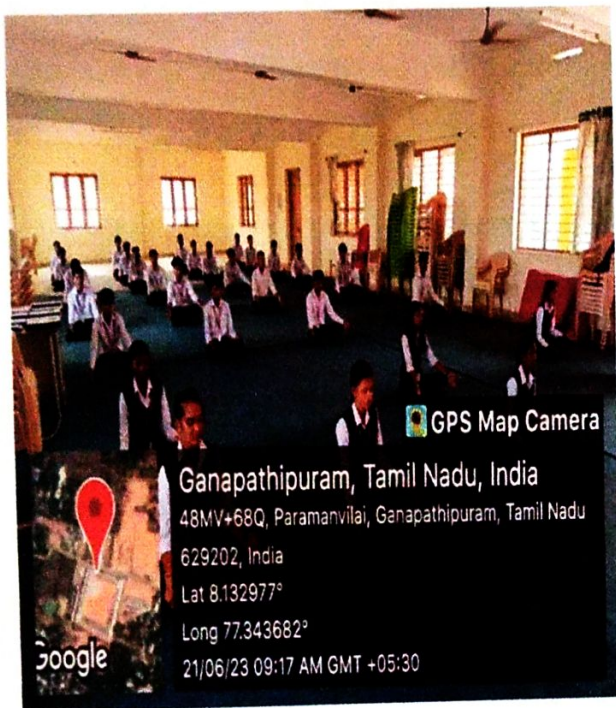
2. Linking Aadhar card with Voter Id:

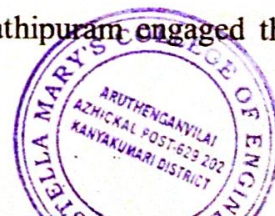


5. Tobacco Awareness Programme:

7. Medical Camp:

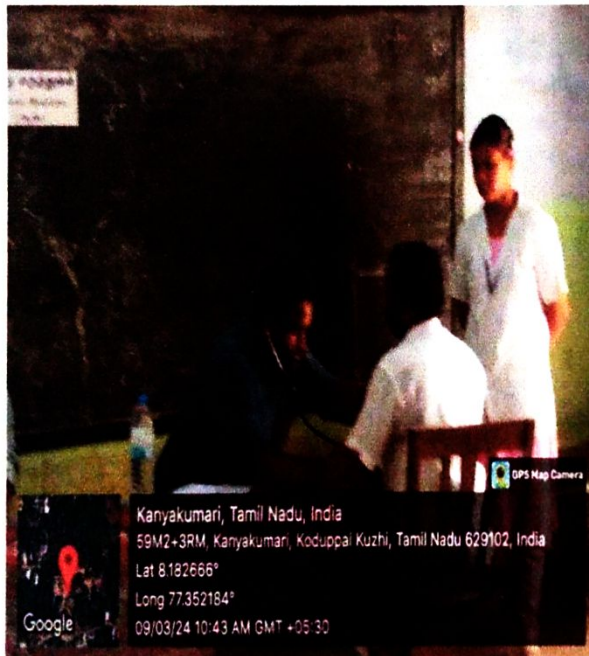

8. Medical Camp – General:

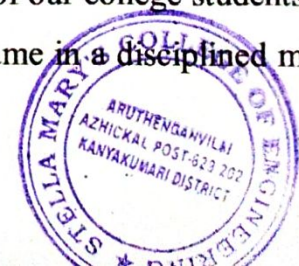

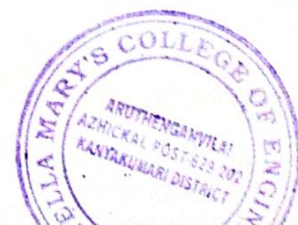
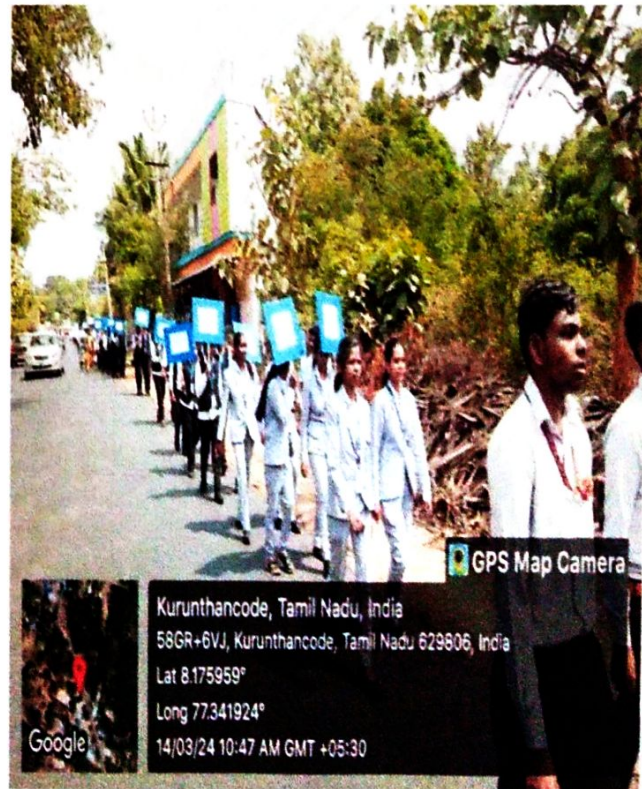
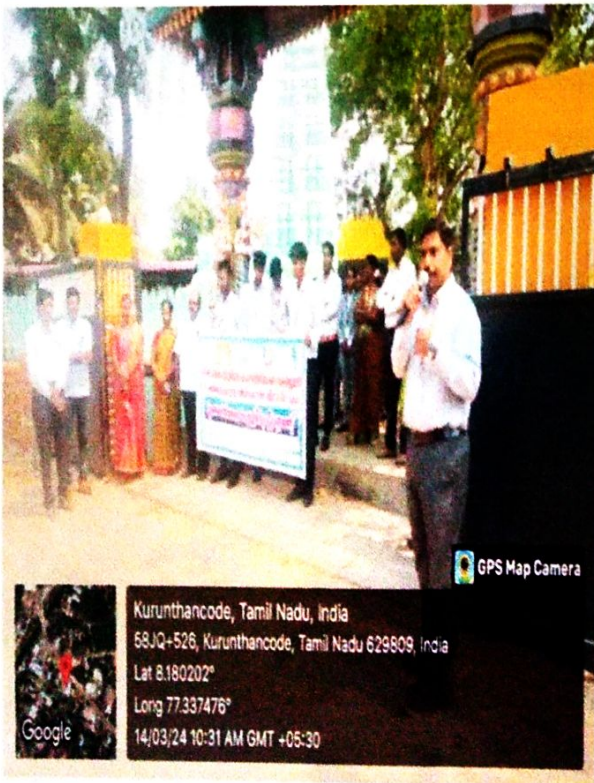
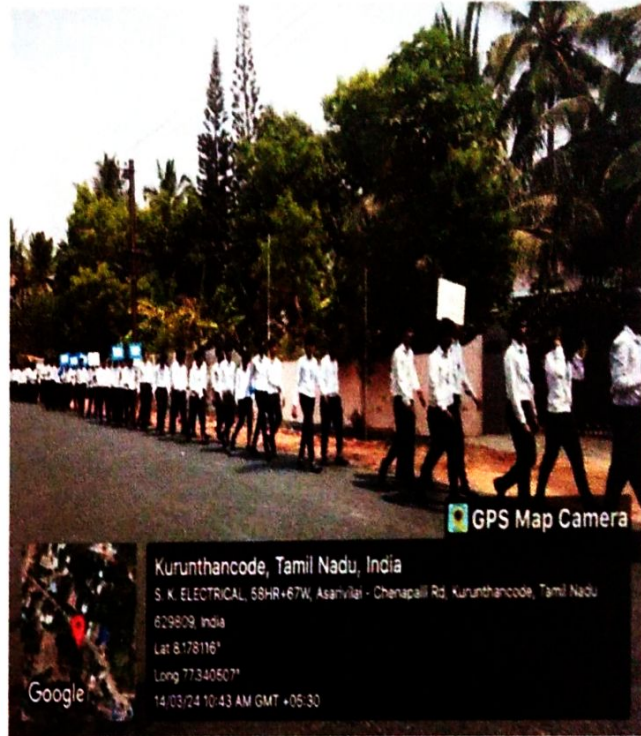


9. Rally for No-Tobacco:

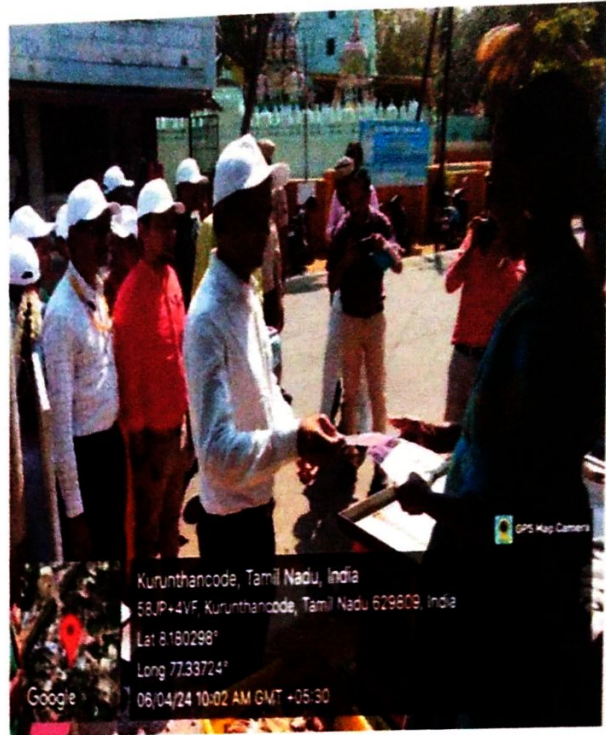
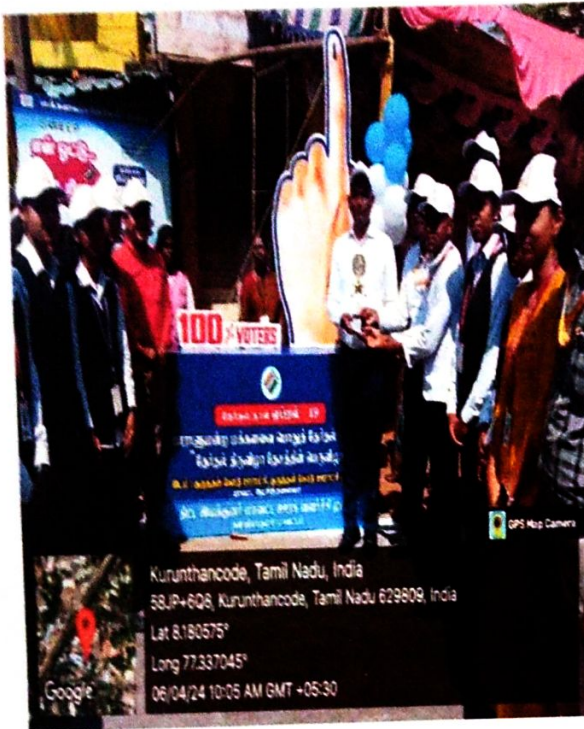
