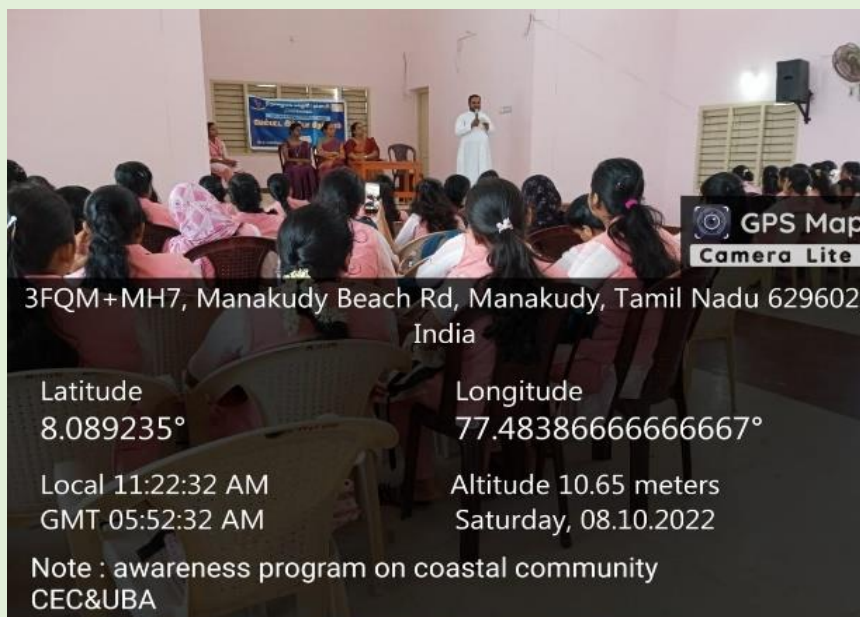
ACTIVITY 2:
