### **ACTIVITY 1:**

Title of the Activity: Trucking camp and cleaning the plastic waste on 11.08.2022

**Need of the Activity:** To raise awareness about plastic pollution and promote community involvement in environmental conservation by cleaning up plastic waste in a designated area

### **ACTIVITY 2:**

### **ACTIVITY 4:**

## **Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)):**

#### **ACTIVITY 5:**

### **ACTIVITY 6:**

This activity ensures that everyone can easily access their Aadhar, essential for availing government services and benefits.
