Degree College, Bijbehara vide order No: DCB/Order/1225, dated:16-08-2024 to organize Gram Sabha under Unnat Bharat Abiyan (UBA) in the village Kanelwal falling under Tehsil Bijbehara. The village comprises of more than 500 houses and has a central importance in the area.

The Committee visited the village on the said date and organized the Gram Sabha in the Govt. High School, Kanelwan. The Gram Sabha witnessed a plentiful participation from villagers including the village head (Numbardar), Sarpanch and Chairman Auqaf Committee of the Village. Besides, the Naib-Tehsildar of the Area was also on the occasion. During the Gram Sabha following issues were raised and discussed:

- 1. There is urgent need of up gradation of high school into higher secondary school. The villagers requested that matter may be taken up with the chief Education Officer, Anantnag.
- 2. Encroachment of the footpaths by the shopkeepers and street vendors leading to frequent accidents. The villagers were assured that the matter may be taken up with the district administration for its redressal.
- 3. Roadside dumping of household wastes. The Auquaf committee of the village was apprised to ensure that the practice of roadside dumping of wastes shall be avoided to prevent pollution.
- 4. Clearance of old and dried chinar trees posing threat to the life of commuters. The matter shall be taken up with the district administration.





During the Gram Sabha following issues were raised and discussed:

- 1. The village has a model higher secondary school with an enrollment of 587 students. There is no provision portable water in the school premesis. Hence, there is an urgent need of establishment of Portable water facility (Kent).
- 2. Construction of drains and bunds at multiple locations in the village. The villagers requested that the matter may be taken with higher-ups for their speedy redressal.
- 3. The villagers requested that the matter construction of road to THALNARD water scheme may be taken up with the district administration.

A committee was constituted by the principal Govt. Degree College, Bijbehara vide order No: DCB/Ord/1220, dated: 19-08-2024 to organize Gram Sabha under Unnat Bharat Abiyan (UBA) in the village Lehandajan falling under Tehsil Saller. The village comprises of more than 550 houses.

The Committee visited the village on the said date and organized the Gram Sabha at Govt. Middle School Bugmud, Lehandajan. The Gram Sabha witnessed a plentiful participation from villagers including the village head (Numbardar), Sarpanch and Chairman Auqaf Committee of the Village. During the Gram Sabha following issues were raised and discussed:

- 1. The village has two middle schools with an enrollment of about 600 hundred students. Unfortunately, there is no high school. The students of the village have to travel a distance of 5Km to Watterhama for high school. The villagers requested that the matter of upgradation of one of the middle schools to high school may be taken up with the district administration through UBA programme.
- 2. Construction of footpath at middle school Bugmud of the village needs to be taken on priority basis as it poses a serious challenge to the students due to its sloppy nature.
- 3. The villagers requested that the washroom at Middle School Bungam of the village may be renovated so that it becomes fully functional
- 4. The village has a dispensary and an ambulance. The ambulance has been purchased out of the punchayat fund of the village. Unfortunately, the ambulance has been hijacked by Primary Health Centre Saller. The villagers requested that matter may be taken up with the CMO of the district so that the ambulance shall be freed for the poor villagers.


