Household Survey Conducted in Adopted Village Meensarkar, Bari Brahmana Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Participating Institute {PI} Dogra Degree College

The UBA Unit of Dogra Degree College inaugurated its five days Household survey in the College on 11th of October 2023 under the guidance of Ms. Bela Thakur, Principal, Dogra Degree College, and under the supervision of Mr. Balwant Singh UBA PI Coordinator, Dogra Degree College. The principal in her inaugural address enlightened the UBA Volunteers regarding the importance of the survey. She shared some valuable thoughts and motivated them to participate in this survey actively. Mr. Balwant Singh UBA Coordinator familiarized students with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. He also provided knowledge on the UBA household survey. UBA volunteers quickly began their preparations for the next day in the discussion of the first meeting. Tasks were listed and divided among the volunteers by the coordinator. A meeting was held in Meensarkar Village Panchayat with the Sarpanch, Mr. Bharat Bhushan on 11th October 2023. The meeting was held for the village and household level survey forms distribution and collection of data. The village survey form was given to the Panchayat member and detailed documentation was explained to the sarpanch. The Sarpanch also briefed about the village, the total number of wards, the total households, and the details of Panchayat members The PI, Coordinator Mr. Balwant Singh also suggested to the Sarpanch that the villagers can also suggest any requirement for their village so that it can be undertaken under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan activity. The UBA Coordinator of Dogra Degree College briefed the Sarpanch and Panchayat members regarding the village-level survey data filling.

UBA Unit of Dogra Degree College on the second day which is 12th of October 2023 conducted a baseline household survey in the adopted village Meensarkar, Bari Brahmana, Samba made 5 groups comprising 7 students in each group. As instructed by the PI coordinator UBA unit DDC, all the volunteers systematically dispersed in two wards (ward number 2 and ward number 3) as per plan. The survey team of DDC was given full support by the Village Sarpanch, Mr. Bharat Bhushan, and by the ward members who shared the information of the total houses to be surveyed and deputed an assistant for carrying out the task smoothly Volunteers went to houses in these wards and gathered information like general household information, waste collection system, family member information, migration status, information about government schemes for the villagers, source of water, source of energy and power, major problems in village agriculture inputs, landholding information, etc.

The volunteers were assigned to wards no. 1 and 5 on the third day, which is October 13. The volunteers were very enthusiastic about the task at hand and prepared to gather as much data as they could for the sake of the hamlet. The volunteers' work on the second day's tasks made

the rest of the village aware of the survey, which improved efficiency in the villagers' and volunteers' cooperation. During the data collection process, the volunteers noticed that many villagers were either not enrolled in any government scheme or had not received any benefits from them. Examples of such schemes include the PM Jan Dhan Yojana, Sukanya Samridhi Yojana, Mudra Yojana, PM Suraksha Bima Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Fasal Bima Yojana, PM Awas Yojana, Janani Suraksha Yojana, Kaushal Vikas Yojana, and others.

The volunteers were assigned to wards 7, 8 & 9 on the fourth day, which was the 21st of October 2023. Like on earlier days, they dispersed, talked with various families, and gathered data about the households. In some wards, volunteers discovered that some houses were shuttered, and in some cases, the information was given to the volunteers after initial disagreement.

Dr. Bela Thakur, Principal of Dogra Degree College, appreciated the efforts of the whole Survey team under the supervision of Mr. Balwant Singh, UBA Coordinator, Dogra Degree College for completing the survey. The survey was completed with the full cooperation of village Sarpanch Sh. Bharat Bhushan Meensarkar panchayat along with Sh. Shabir Ahmed, Panch Ward no 1, Anita Kumari, Panch Ward no 2, Sh. - On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November 2023, a meeting was hosted by Dr. Bela Thakur, the Principal of Dogra Degree College. The Sarpanch of Meen Sarkar Village Sh. Bharat Bhushan was the primary speaker along with Mr. Balwant Singh, Pl, Coordinator, and two student representatives from the UBA committee.
- The Sarpanch began the discussion by elaborating on the problems faced by Meen Sarkar Village. He explained that the major issue in the village was the pollution caused by the nearby factories. The pollutants from the factory area were adversely affecting the health of the villagers, resulting in a high incidence of heart diseases, lung problems, and other health-related issues. Moreover, the untreated water discharged from the factories was contaminating the canal water, making it unfit for consumption. The pollution had also altered the taste and quality of the groundwater in the village.

Following the presentation of the problems, the meeting participants discussed possible remedial measures to address the issues in Meen Sarkar Village. Several ideas were exchanged, including initiating discussions with the factory owners to ensure they adopt proper pollution

control measures and supporting the villagers in accessing clean and safe drinking water. It was also suggested that a joint effort should be made to raise awareness about the environmental impact of the factories on the village.





### A Baseline Household Survey Conducted in Lower Kartholi Village


The UBA (Unnat Bharat Abhiyan) Baseline Household Survey was conducted on November 4, 2023, in Lower Kartholi Village by Dogra Degree College. The survey aimed to collect baseline data and assess the needs and living conditions of the villagers, as well as to understand their requirements for future development projects. This report provides an overview of the survey's organization, participants, and key findings. Before conducting the survey, a meeting was held on the 3rd of November, 2023 with the members of the UBA committee from Dogra Degree College, including two student representatives, Chiranjeev Singh Gill and Manya Bhardwaj, and punch of the village Mrs. Sushma Devi. The meeting took place at the house of the village Panch, Mrs. Sushma Devi. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the survey's objectives and seek approval from the village Panch. Prior permission was obtained from the village Sarpanch, Mr. Angrez Singh, for conducting the survey. This ensured that the survey had official authorization and support. A total of 31 students and 6 teachers from Dogra Degree College participated in the survey. The village survey form was given to the Panchayat member and detailed documentation was explained to the panch. The panch also briefed about the village, the total number of wards, the total households, and the details of Panchayat members The PI, Coordinator Mr. Balwant Singh also suggested to the panch that the villagers can also suggest any requirement for their village so that it can be undertaken under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan activity. The UBA Coordinator of Dogra Degree College briefed the Sarpanch and Panchayat members regarding the village-level survey data filling

Lower Kartholi Village is divided into 8 wards. To ensure comprehensive coverage, groups of 2-3 students were assigned to each ward. Teachers from Dogra Degree College accompanied the students in each group to provide guidance and support during the survey. The survey provided an excellent learning opportunity for the students. It allowed them to engage with the community, understand their issues, and gain practical experience in data collection and social interaction. Students had the chance to interact with the villagers and learn about their lifestyles, challenges, and aspirations. This helped foster a sense of community involvement. The survey covered various aspects of village life, including demographics, economic conditions, healthcare, education, and infrastructure.

The Key findings include Demographics: The village has a diverse population. The average household size is 4-5 members. Economic Conditions: Many households in the village rely on agriculture as their primary source of income. However, there is a need for skill development and diversification in livelihood options. Healthcare: Access to healthcare facilities is limited, and villagers expressed a need for better healthcare services and awareness programs.

Education: While there are schools in the village, there is a desire for improved infrastructure and educational opportunities for children. Infrastructure: Villagers highlighted the need for electricity supply, and sanitation facilities along with a garbage collection system. The UBA Baseline Household Survey conducted by Dogra Degree College students in Lower Kartholi Village on November 4, 2023, was a valuable exercise in community engagement and data collection. The survey provided students with a practical learning experience while enabling them to understand the needs and concerns of the villagers. The findings from this survey will be instrumental in planning and implementing future development projects in the village, aligning with the objectives of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. Dr. Bela Thakur, Principal of Dogra Degree College, appreciated the efforts of the whole Survey team under the supervision of Mr. Balwant Singh, UBA Coordinator, Dogra Degree College for completing the survey. The survey was completed with the full cooperation of village Sarpanch Sh. Angrez Singh along with Smt.Sushma Devi, Panch Ward no 2 and Sh. Hari Krishan, panch ward no.6 This survey was made possible through the collaborative effort of the college, village Panchayat, and the active participation of the students, teachers, and community members. It is a step towards fostering sustainable rural development in Lower Kartholi Village.

# Activity-10 Main Key Findings from the Data Collection

- A baseline household survey was carried out by the Dogra Degree College UBA cell in the five adopted villages of Palli, Meensarkar, Kartholi Upper, Kartholi Lower & Smailpur, Bari Brahmana, and Samba. The volunteers were systematically distributed throughout several wards according to the plans of the UBA cell DDC. The representatives of the Village Sarpanch of Smailpur, Sh. Balwant Singh, the Sarpanch of Upper Kartholi, Sh. Tarsem Singh, the Sarpanch of Palli, and Sh. Randhir Sharma, the Sarpanch of Lower Kartholi, Sh. Angrez Singh and the ward members who shared the details of all the houses that needed to be surveyed and assigned an assistant to ensure a smooth survey process provided the DDC survey team with full support.
- All these wards' homes were surveyed by volunteers who collected data on a variety of issues, including general household information, the waste collection system, family member information, migration status, details about government programs for the villagers, sources of energy, and power and water, significant issues with village agriculture inputs, info on landholding, etc.
- During the data collection process, the volunteers identified that many villagers were either not enrolled in any government schemes or had not received any benefits from them. A few instances of such schemes include the PM Jan Dhan Yojana, Sukanya Samridhi Yojana, Mudra Yojana, PM Suraksha Bima Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Fasal Bima Yojana, PM Awas Yojana, Janani Suraksha Yojana, Kaushal Vikas Yojana, and others.
- The Volunteers discovered that these individuals needed family planning counselling, which the volunteers also provided, and that the families were extended. However, it wasn't the only issue. There were also a lot of other problems, such as poor living conditions, social taboos, roads, trash, drainage systems, homelessness, and health issues.

- The Volunteers also found that the surrounding industry's pollution was the community's main problem. The villagers' health was being negatively impacted by the pollutants coming from the factory region, which was leading to an increased risk of heart disease, lung troubles, and other ailments. Furthermore, the canal water was becoming contaminated by the untreated water that the companies were discharging, rendering it unsafe for human consumption. The pollution had also changed the village's groundwater's flavor and quality.
- The villages have highlighted a need for improved healthcare services and awareness initiatives due to limited access to healthcare facilities.
- The population of the village is diverse. A typical home consists of four to five people. The main source of income for many households in the village is agriculture. On the other hand, diversification of livelihood options and skill development is required.
- Although the hamlet has schools, there is a need for better facilities and kid-focused learning opportunities.

The villagers emphasized the necessity for a garbage collection system, sanitary amenities, and an electrical supply





The UBA Cell of Dogra Degree College is committed to organizing more such programs in the future to empower communities and drive positive change in society.








