#### 1. Road Construction

 Ongoing efforts to promote the rights and benefits for children with physical disabilities.

#### 10. Veterinary Care Initiative

 Designation of a caretaker for veterinary needs and maintenance within the community.

#### 1. Lack of Power Supply

Thalimangalam Village currently experiences power shortages, affecting daily life.

#### 2. Ration Shop Infrastructure

The absence of a concrete floor in the ration shop leads to spoilage of food items due to water seepage.

#### 3. Safety Measures

 Urgent need for speed breakers to reduce frequent accidents in Thalimangalam.

#### 4. Water Tank and Bus Stand

 Proposals for constructing a water tank and a bus stand to enhance community infrastructure.

#### 5. Educational Initiatives

 Headmistress Ms. Revathi emphasized the need for evening classes for residents aged 15 and above, including those with disabilities.

#### 6. Employment Opportunities

 Requirement for a rope plant in two villages to create 100 days of job opportunities focused on cleaning and maintaining local ponds.


#### **Conclusion**

#### **Special Grama Shabha Discussion points**

- 1. Water Sanitization: Village lack access to clean and safe drinking water, leading to health issues and waterborne diseases. Ineffective water sanitization systems exacerbate this problem, impacting overall community health.
- **2. Waste Management**: Inadequate waste management practices in the areas result in littering, pollution, and unsanitary living conditions. The lack of proper disposal methods poses significant environmental and health risks to the community.
- 3. Skill Development for Single Parent Women: Single parent women in rural villages often struggle with economic independence due to limited access to skill development opportunities, making it difficult for them to provide for their families and achieve self-sufficiency.
- **4. Medical Health Center**: The absence of a local medical health center leaves residents without access to essential healthcare services. This lack of medical facilities increases vulnerability to untreated health conditions and emergencies.
- **5. Clean Hygiene**: Poor hygiene practices in the communities, driven by limited access to education and resources, contribute to health issues and reduce the quality of life. Promoting clean hygiene practices is essential for overall community well-being.

- **6. Special Education for All Classes**: There is a significant gap in educational resources for children with special needs in rural areas. The lack of special education services prevents these children from receiving appropriate support, hindering their development and inclusion.
- 7. Cattle Monitoring in Cultivation Areas: Farmers in rural areas face challenges in monitoring cattle health and productivity, impacting agricultural output. Inefficient cattle management practices can lead to economic losses and reduced food security.
- **8.** Computer-Based Training: Limited access to technology and computer-based training in rural villages hampers residents' ability to develop digital skills, which are increasingly important for employment and entrepreneurship in the modern economy.
- **9. Skill Development Courses**: There is a lack of comprehensive skill development courses tailored to the needs of rural populations, leading to high unemployment rates and underutilization of human resources within the community.
- **10. Entrepreneurs' Skill Development**: Aspiring entrepreneurs in rural areas often lack the necessary skills and knowledge to start and sustain their businesses. The absence of targeted training programs limits economic growth and job creation in these communities.

- 5. The benefits provided from Anganwadi scheme for pregnant women, nursing mothers, and children were discussed.


- 6. The current issues faced by the villagers, their solutions, and future requirements were also discussed.

street light facilities, rain water harvesting and relocating the wine shop to some other place as per the villager's request.


