### Activity 1

#### Distribution of Bins for Effective Waste Segregation

We successfully distributed two bins to all the families in Kandi Thanda for dry and wet waste segregation. This initiative aimed to encourage responsible waste management practices among local families.

#### Raising Awareness of Waste Segregation

The team reached out to families and educated them on the significance of segregating dry and wet waste as a follow-up plan. A detailed explanation of the color-coding system, where blue-colour bins are designated for dry waste and green-colour bins for wet waste was provided. Additionally, this was explained with emphasis on the importance of recycling to reduce the amount of trash sent to landfills.





## Activity -2

### Registration Process for Sukanya Samridhi Yojana

The Sukanya Samridhi Yojana (SSY), a flagship savings scheme launched in 2015, under the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao campaign, aimed to secure the financial future of girl children. As a follow-up plan, the team encouraged the families to prioritize their daughter's well-being and invest in her future, despite being a significant challenge. Our efforts focused on empowering them to safeguard their girl child's economic independence and create a brighter future and accordingly, 23 - 25 family members showed interest in registering in the scheme.



## Activity -3

### Registration of Birth Certificate and Enrollment in Sukanya Samridhi Yojana

A total of 23-25 families expressed interest in the scheme. The team facilitated their enrollment by escorting them to the post office, where lecturers assisted with:

**Activity 4: Commencing the registration process for birth certificates**

As per the registration process, the residents to become a part of the Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana are required to possess Birth certificates and upon inquiry, it was found that they have never registered for birth certificates. To facilitate the issue of birth certificates, the team with the help of Kandi Headman, Mr. Suresh Naik, approached the local Mandal Revenue Officer (MRO) to rectify the issue. As it was challenging at this moment to provide the residents with birth certificates, the MRO promised to consider the Bonafide certificate issued by the schools/colleges to provide the birth certificate.

It was quite surprising for the team members to know the ignorance among the residents about the norms of birth certificates.
