Main discussion points from the meeting:

- Motivated the cleaning staff by providing water bottles and towel, required for them.
- The Panchayath has a Varumai Olippu Sangam (VPRC) for scheduled castes and Tribes, where they provide loan for business development from 15,000 to 20,000. Kodiyyur village people has utilised the funds for the development of their business activities and inturn received “**Manimegalai Award**”
- Motivated the students who are best at extracurricular activities by showcasing their talents to people and appreciated them by giving rewards.
- Educated on the schemes related to honey collection, poultry development and explained the procedures for joining the above said schemes in detail.
- Many people have their land document (patta), but the process of house construction is not yet started.
- As the Panchayat does not have Agri Cooperative Society, they have passed a petition for the new cooperative society for the panchayat.
- As there is no wine shop in and around the Panchayat, the President and people have deicded to make a resolution and ask permission to the authoritis for its approval.
- Re-establishing the Athikadavu-Avinadhi scheme for water usage for the farmers.
- The people adked for a parttime ration shop at Kooranur as the prevailing ration shops are far away from their location.
- The president has promised that they will provide water facilities for farming activities in the hill areas
