At the inaugural session, Dr. Nalin Sharma, Associate Dean of Outreach and UBA PI Coordinator, welcomed the Director, RCI Coordinator and UBA Core Committee member with bouquets and the traditional lighting of the lamp. In the opening address, IIT Jammu Director Prof. Manoj Singh Gaur emphasized IIT Jammu's crucial role as an RCI in driving the UBA initiative in the region, highlighting the importance of collaboration among participating institutions to address the diverse challenges faced by rural communities and their social responsibility towards their UBA adopted villages. He also informed the gathering that IIT, in its PI role, will adopt at least one village annually to expand its reach in the coming years. The workshop continued with a speech by Prof. Abhay Sharma, Regional Coordinator of UBA at IIT Jammu. In his address, he encouraged the coordinators to develop more proposals addressing village needs, offering the assistance of RCI IIT Jammu in proposal writing to secure funding under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan scheme.

Participating Institute (PI) officials/coordinators were formally welcomed, and the meeting began with introductions. The attending participating institutions presented their work in their adopted villages during 2024-25 and received awards based on their UBA ground development progress, Dr. Nalin Sharma also presented IIT Jammu's achievements in adopted villages as a participating institution. The top four awardees were Dogra Degree College, MIET Jammu, MIER Jammu, and Govt. Degree College Ram Nagar. Dr. Karan Nathwani, RCI IIT Jammu UBA Core Committee Member, guided participants on writing proposals to secure UBA funding for adopted villages.

In the review meeting held at IIT Jammu, the regional coordinating Institute for UBA, Dogra Degree College under the leadership of its PI coordinator, Mr. Balwant Singh, under the support and guidance of Dr. Bela Thakur, Principal, Dogra Degree College, was awarded a certificate of Merit for the 1st and 2nd Quarter 2024-2025. The college was recognized as the best-participating institution among the Union Territories Jammu & Ladakh. The event concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Nalin Sharma, followed by lunch. 1. Dr. Ajaz Ahmed, PI Coordinator of Govt. PG College Bhaderwah, suggested that the UBA scheme should specify Academic/Promotional benefits for coordinators, students and Institutions for their societal work, similar to those offered by NSS and NCC social schemes
2. Encountering the problems in spending the money provided for survey due to hard rules specific to Govt. Colleges (PI Institutes)
3. More initiatives/activities should be suggested by RCI for implementation by PI Institutes, for this more funds should be given to PI institutes via RCI for those activities.
4. More frequent Offline orientation programs should be conducted.

They discussed ways to maintain cleanliness and the importance of community-driven efforts to protect natural resources.

The program significantly enhanced the understanding of the villagers regarding water conservation and the urgency of adopting sustainable water practices. Many villagers expressed a commitment to implementing water-saving measures in their homes.

The villagers were also encouraged to adopt sustainable practices, not just for water conservation but also for keeping their environment clean in the long term. The initiative helped build a foundation for future projects aimed at improving water literacy and environmental sustainability.
