


### ACTIVITY 4:




#### ACTIVITY 5:




#### ACTIVITY 6:




#### ACTIVITY 7:


## ACTIVITY 9:

A Training Program, 'Silai ki Padhai' on sewing, embroidery, stitching has been offered as a part of doing something valuable for the Local Tribal Community. It was a 42 days training program after which Completion Certificate was offered to the participants. 20 Tribal Women were identified to give training of stitching. The modules were:


- Introduction To Industrial Sewing Machine And Handling
- Scrunchies And Potli Bag Stitching, Seams Stitching, Basic Embroidery Stitches, Fabric Bookmark Making
- Zipper Attachment, Mobile Sling Bag Design And Stitching, Zipper Pouch Stationery Bag Design And Stitching, Ruffle And Other Fabric Manipulation Techniques
- Kurti - Measurement, Pattern On Fabric, Blouse - Measurement, Pattern On Fabric, Blouse – Stitching
- Product Development - Embroidery Based, Product Development - Paper Bag, Product Development - Fabric Bag
- Salwar Pant - Measurement, Pattern On Fabric, Cushion Cover - Cutting - Embroidery And Stitching, Saree - Fall / Pico


