Half Yearly Report (August to November 2024)

1. Inauguration of Skill Development Centre – 26 July 2024

Venue: Senior Secondary Government School, Bichpuri

Chief Guest: Mr. L. N. Mathur, Managing Director, The Wipe Hotwire Private Limited

Description: The Skill Development Centre was inaugurated to promote hands-on vocational training for rural youth and women. This marks a milestone in NIIT University's ongoing efforts to foster employability through local empowerment initiatives under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA). Number of Participants 47 Students and 15 Industry Guest, Faculty and Staff.

2. Sewing Machine Installation – 3 August 2024

Venue: Senior Secondary Government School, Bichpuri

Support: Sponsored by Wipe Hotwire, facilitated by PrabhuG Sewa Mission Foundation

Description: A sewing machine was installed at the Skill Development Centre to enable training in tailoring and garment design. This initiative supports economic independence for local women and aligns with UBA's mission of capacity-building through skill training. No. of participants 7.
