

Report on “World Rabies Day”

UBA in Collaboration with NSS Unit, Kuttukaran Polytechnic College celebrated World Rabies Day on 8th October 2025. The resource persons Ms.Lidiya K L, Junior health Inspector, FHC, Alangad. The aim of the program is to create awareness on Rabies and its impact. The World Rabies Day celebration was started with an introduction on street dogs and its nuisances. The **World Rabies Awareness Program** was organized at **Kuttukaran Polytechnic College** with the objective of educating students and the community about the **prevention and control of rabies**, a fatal but preventable viral disease. The program aimed to spread awareness about the importance of **vaccination, responsible pet ownership, and early medical attention** after animal bites.
