1. Introduction

Under the aegis of the **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)**, the UBA Club of **Govt. Polytechnic Sundernagar** successfully organized a **Digital Security Awareness Campaign** in village Patyora. The campaign was conducted to address the rising cases of online frauds and cybercrimes in rural areas and to educate villagers about safe and responsible digital practices.

- Distribution of awareness messages and safety tips
- Interaction and doubt-clearing sessions with villagers
