## Summary Report:

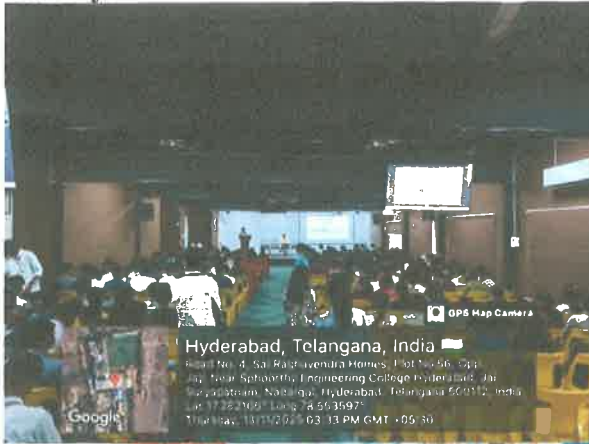
