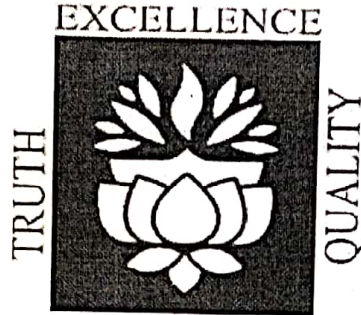

Aim of the program:

The aim of this visit was to collaborate with nearby Government schools and establish an agreement to support higher-grade students by providing technical skills, basic programming knowledge, career guidance, self-defense training for girls, and creative craft-making activities. This initiative by the Seabytes Club, CSE Department, Sphoorthy Engineering College aims to create a pathway for school students to achieve their educational and career goals.

Objectives of Handson Session:

1. To plan outreach activities for government schools and orphanages in order to support education and social welfare.

3. To identify the requirements of selected orphanages and provide donations such as books and washed clothes.

Between

PARTIES

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Offer necessary academic content, training materials, and logistics support
- Submit completion reports for CSR documentation and impact measurement
- Ensure discipline and safety protocols during activities

- Facilitate access to students and required classrooms/labs
- Provide support staff for smooth coordination of activities
- Ensure student discipline and participation
- Share feedback and improvement suggestions
- Allow collection of photographs, attendance, and feedback for CSR reporting

DURATION & RENEWAL

- This Agreement remains valid until both the parties agree upon the terms and conditions from the date of signing
- It may be **discontinued** based on mutual consent in writing

MONITORING & REPORTING

- Progress review will be conducted quarterly
- Activity reports with photographs and outcomes will be jointly documented

CONFIDENTIALITY & DATA PROTECTION

- Both Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of student-related data
- Data collected shall be used strictly for CSR reporting and academic development purposes

NO FINANCIAL LIABILITY

- This collaboration **does not involve any commercial or monetary transaction** between the Parties unless mutually agreed upon in writing

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- Training content remains the property of SPHN
- Student-created works may be used for academic and CSR publicity purposes with acknowledgment

TERMINATION CLAUSE

Either Party may terminate this Agreement with **30 days written notice** if:

- There is a material breach of terms
- Activities are no longer feasible due to operational constraints

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes arising shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussion. If unresolved, the matter will be referred to the jurisdiction of **Hyderabad Courts, Telangana State.**
