Need of the Activity: Lack of awareness related Covid-19pandemic.


Brief Description of activities:



BriefDescriptionofactivities:

The inaugural function of value-added product production unit started on 02.03.2022 from 10.30am – 12.30pm at Central Herbal Garden, Nagamangalam. There were about forty (40) participants such as SHG members, Professors, Coordinators, students from BBA and BCom participated.

Mr. C. Jeyachandran, Senior Coordinator welcome the gathering and described elaborately about the perennial fund of Moringa Value Added Products Promotion by Unnat Bharat Abiyan (UBA) 2.0. He told about various initiatives of preserving forty varieties of herbal medicines produced from herbal plants and trees in the garden since 1994. He mentioned about the UBA project initiatives were executed by Prof. L. Arokiam after consultation with experts at Delhi. Participatory institutes were asked to initiate the project at least of five villages around the vicinity from Central Herbal Garden which was accessible to implementation. He also emphasized the importance of the project which was mainly for students and self help group members from the UBA villages. Herbal medicines, Solar Powered Leaves Dryer, Moringa Value Added Products and its samples were displayed.

Rev. Fr. M. Berchmans SJUBA PI-Coordinator gave an inaugural talk mentioning the praise worthy notes about the dignified personalities for their valuable presence. He denoted the commencement of the project at 2017 by Human Resource Department (HRD) recommending higher education institutes to adopt five villages at least. He prioritized the importance of the training centre and its usages for creating hundreds of trainees from it since 1986. He told about the value added products were much beneficial to SHG members and farmers and would be marketed as income generation program. He emphasized on the importance of joint activity always leading to success. He assured that the college would continuously support the initiatives. Above all he showed importance on at least ten (10) beneficiaries families would be the successive stories from the project.

- **Mr. K. Vellaichamy,** President, Nagamangalam Panchayat gave a presidential address recognizing firstly the dignitaries, SHG members, staffs and students. He stated the contamination and adulteration of food lead to health challenges of the individuals and created medicinal dependency syndrome. He requested the moringa promotion project might be implemented for the beneficial of their Panchayat SHG members at first. He assured that any help arising out of the project would be supported by the Panchayat with immediate cause.
- Rev. Dr. Leonard Fernando SJ, Rector appreciated the efforts of the team remembering the visionary thematic deeds of Rev. Dr. I Jesudasson SJ idealized Ghandhian Philosophical concepts. He told about the founder and his educational contributory deeds for the students. He also praised that having the founder as his class professor during collage days was ever haunting in mind. He admired about unfamiliarity of the products, its usages and happy about getting known the all powerful parts of the trees were as valuable as precious ones. Iron content seventy five percent (75%) in the product was seven (7) times greater than the orange. He told that the good initiatives by SHEPHERD department were noteworthy on promotion of herbal saplings at home and neighborhood communities. He pointed out on any of the good deeds implemented might be appreciable and could be useful to the campus nutri-corner. He offered the advisory points on importance of the moringa products to the farmers' families, their children and malnutrition persons. He emphasized on the arsenic deposit within the individuals who would consume paddy rice without soaking and washing it properly for hours. He told that it had poisoned many of the Indians who ate paddy rice inadequately referring from the latest BBC news article. He happily told about the valuable information on government grants and subsidies for the promotion of agriculture sector organic businesses. He told that an individual could receive about twenty five lackhs of amount for doing business. Dr. P. Balathandayuthabani shared about consumption of Moringa capsules were more familiar in the European and Western countries though the Indians were less aware of it. He insisted upon the innovative work and

its originality instead of copying from other sources with example UBER was successive and OLA was unsuccessful due its copying model of work. Above all, he assured that his company would support in promoting the value added products produced by Extension Department – SHEPHERD.


