UBA wing distributed the ration-kits to 50 families under 'Koi bhukha na soye Abhiyaan' in pandemic lockdown time. 'Koi Bhukha Na Soye Abhiyaan' during lockdown-2020, 50 kits distribution in 5 Adopted Villages. (01-15 May 2020)

In the situation of COVID-19, pandemic lockdown during 2020, ABES Engineering College, Ghaziabad (UP) took initiative to identify the food supply demand for the poor villagers in different villages adopted by UBA_ABESEC under the campaign titled as "KOI BHUKHA NA SOYE" of Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow Uttar Pradesh, as per circular wide from AKTU VC office no. **AKTU/ VCO/2020/ 10760** dated on April 12, 2020.

In this regard, ABESEC administration nominated two faculty members Mr. Rohit Rastogi (Sr. Asst. Prof., CSE) and Mr. Tarun Kumar Sharma (Sr. Asst. Prof., MCA) to establish the contact with the Pradhans of different villages and to find out the number of poor families in these villages. As result of regular contacts, till 19 April, 2020, they

identified total 50 families consist of approx 200 members in three different villages named as Masuri, Matiala, Kanauja during the period of 1st may 2020 to 13th may 2020. Each food supply kit consisting of 10kg wheat, 1 lt. edible oil, 1 packet salt, 2kg pulse, 5kg Rice, some basic spices, 5 soaps for hand wash, 1 toothpaste etc. costing around Rs. 600/- to Rs. 650/-.

Total budget of Rs. 32500/- was approved by honorable Director Prof. (Dr.) Shailesh Tiwari Ji and the kind support of President Shri. Neeraj Goel Ji, Vice President Shri. Sachin Goel Ji for this novel campaign titled as "**KOI BHUKHA NA SOYE**".

- 10. Screening and Contact Tracing




UBA-ABESEC Team Conducted Webinar on 'Role and Initiative by Ghaziabad Administration for Village Development' (18 Oct., 2020)





To make awareness on


- 1. Disease outbreaks increase proportionally with increases in intensive aquaculture.



The trainer then started giving brief about different kinds of Yoga such as Ashtanga Yoga in which he told about the eight limbs of Yoga as yama, niyama, asana, pranayama, pratyahara, dharana, dhyana and samadhi.

Then trainer gave some brief about the Suksham Yoga by tell that it is a simple Yoga technique for relaxation and mental wellbeing. Then he started with Khadi Chakra Aasan which is important for starching the spine and abdominal area of the body, followed by neck exercises such as bridge pose, Vasisthasana, etc. He told about Anulom-Vilom breathing for regulation of air properly, the trainer also teaches students about shoulder exercises, Knees exercise, Height increasing exercises.

Trainer taught students about chair pose (Utkat Aasan), Tricone Aasan, Vriksh Aasan which helps in making concentration Padmasana (lotus pose), Janu Sirsasana Aasan, Chakki chalan

Aasan, Naabhi Darshan Aasan, Vakra Aasan, Titli Aasan(Butterfly Pose), Makar Aasan, Markat Aasan(Monkey Pose), Shek Band Aasan, Shav Aasan, Kapal Bharti and Gulf Godhan Aasan.

The trainer also told students about body in reference with Ayurveda he mentioned that "Body is the composed structure formed by three fundamental categories called Doshas, Dhatus, and Malas. The Doshas are three in number, the Dhatus are seven and Malas are three. He also gave a brief about how to stay healthy with mind and body, how to stay positive and how Yoga helps in doing so.

Towards the end of the session, Prof. (Dr.) Sanjay Kumar Singh sir, Director ABESEC, took time from his busy schedule and addressed the students with his thoughts on Yog and healthy living.

On 21st June 2023, Vote of thanks was given by anchor followed by certificate distribution to guest trainer Sh. Karan Bahadur sir, faculty coordinators and to all the student coordinators of the event by Prof. (Dr.) Amrita Jyoti Ma'am.

The session was a great success ended by taking live feedback from students and faculty members present over there. Dr. Rohit Rastogi sir then gave brief about Yoga to the students by performing some exercises. The session ended with smiles on everyone's faces with Hasya Asan and Shanti Path.
