As a part of collaborative activities to be carried out in UBA villages, MoU has been signed between UBA unit of Sarada Krishna Homoepathic Medical College, Kulasekharam, Kanniyakumari Dist, Tamilnadu and UBA unit of Holy Cross Home Science College, Thoothukudi, Tamil Nadu.

The main objectives of the MoU are:

VILLAGE INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

Village Internship Programme may be organised for a Week jointly by SKHMC and HHSC. A batch of Students of both this College may be placed for a Week Internship Programme at UBA villages of HCHSC. During this Internship Programme Students may be involved in conducting the Health Survey to identify Health issues. As a part of this Programme a Medical Camp may be organized with the support of SKHMC Team for benefiting the rural people. To provide follow up assistance to patients Tele Medicine facility available with SKHMC may be utilised. Certificate of the Internship to the Students may be provided jointly signed by Heads / UBA Coordinators of these Institutions.

ESTABLISHMENT OF HEALTH CENTRES

HHSC may provide minimum infrastructure facilities (A room with furniture facilities) at the campus itself to establish a Health Centre with assistance of Doctors of SKHMC. Thereafter the services of this Health Centre may be extended to the UBA villages.

SUBMISSION OF JOINT PROPOSAL FOR UBA-SEG

Both the Institutions can jointly submit the project proposal to UBA- SEG.

STUDY VISIT PROGRAMME TO SKHMC

A study visit may be arranged for the benefits of Students of Home Science Department of HHSC to visit SKHMC and to get hands on experience in the lab / hospital facilities.
