Progress Report 2019-20

The following events were successfully organized by Unnat Bharat Abhiyan JUIT in Academic Year 2019-20:

1. No Plastic campaign and household survey: 21 Sept, 2019:

Swachhata He Sewa Campaign was launched by the Government of India in 2018, so UBA initiated a campaign of plastic-free village. A team of 30 UBA members visited Dumehar village. Students were divided into 5 groups each consisting of 6 members. Then these 5 groups were scattered and they went to different houses. Firstly the members of each house were greeted properly by every UBA member and then they were briefly explained about the various disadvantages of plastic. We also had banners and posters regarding no use of plastic products and its harmful effects on the environment which helped villagers in better understanding of this campaign. After that each group got survey forms filled by the villagers, various personal details of the respondent were recorded. We also gave them information about the various government schemes and then filled the data regarding how many people were benefitted from these schemes. Then the people were asked about the problems that they were facing and the problems were also noted separately. Their problems were considered and we assured them to provide them with proper solution. The campaign ended up successfully and we hope the problems of the villagers will be solved by the higher authorities.



2. Chawsa School and Village Visit to increase awareness and survey: October 02, 2019:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan JUIT Waknaghat organized a door-to-door survey and no plastic campaign in the chawsa village on 2 October 2019. The team went to the chawsa government school and explained the bad effect of poythene to the student and rose aware for no Also, the members visited houses of people and conduct a survey to check the total number of kaccha and pakka houses and the total number of family members in the house. Apart from the house structure, all problems regarding electricity, water supply, road conditions and discussed the different government scheme from which they are taking benefits. Further, all the problems were noted and forwarded to the higher authorities. With the enthusiasm of the members and the cooperation of the residents, this survey was a success.



3. Richhana & Dumehar Village Visit for survey and no plastic campaign in School: Oct 02, 2019:

The team went to the government school and explained the bad effects of polythene to the students and suggested that they should not use single-use plastic. Apart from the house structure, all problems regarding electricity, water supply, road conditions and the different government schemes from which they are taking benefits. Further, all the problems were noted and forwarded to the higher authorities. With the enthusiasm of the members and the cooperation of the residents, this survey was completed.

4. Farmer workshop organized by UBA in collaboration of DEST project: 02-11 Dec 2019:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan JUIT Waknaghat organized an Workshop for farmers from 2nd Dec to 11th Dec. The campaign was conducted on offline mode in the campus itself and transportation services were provided to farmers for visiting the campus. Many of the modern farming practices were shared with an aim to spread awareness among the people who are unaware of all the benefits of modern farming. The farmers were provided with lecture hall in Vivekanand Bhawan and with the help of ppt's encouraged to use the modern way of agriculture. They were briefly explained about the advantages of modern farming and how to use them for benefit of both themselves and their lands saving their time and resources.
