Progress Report 2022-2023

The following events were successfully organized by Unnat Bharat Abhiyan JUIT in Academic Year 2022-23:

1. Cleanliness and Waste Management Awareness Campaign: April 17, 2022:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) JUIT Waknaghat organized a village survey in Richhana, regarding waste management in households on 17th April 2022. The UBA team started their journey at 10:00 AM after being counseled by our faculty coordinators. The team surveyed seven available houses out of twelve and discussed waste management with the villagers. The survey focused on certain points that as the types of waste available at houses, collections of waste materials, dumping places of waste, availability of cleaners, and distances to travel for dumping waste. The team imparted their knowledge about different kinds of biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste and its segregation before dumping. They found that the villagers had some common problems such as the non-availability of cleaners in the village and the long distances that they had to travel for dumping waste. The villagers usually burnt the waste produced in their household for which the UBA team discussed the alternate ways to tackle that problem. Apart from that the team also discussed the medical facilities and their availability in the village. They found that villagers had to travel to nearby villages for basic medical facilities. After observing and noting down all the problems the survey ended at 12:00 PM. In the end, it was a very successful and memorable event.





2. AIDS Awareness Campaign: April 17, 2022:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan JUIT Waknaghat organized an AIDS Awareness Campaign on 17 April 2022. In the starting of the campaign a rally was organized from lower Waknaghat to the main market of Waknaghat by the members of <u>UBA</u> along with the <u>NCC</u> members of <u>JUIT</u>. Different slogans were raised regarding the HIV prevention. The team also approached local people of Waknaghat and talked to them regarding AIDS and how to prevent it. Then all the members went to the gram panchayat Waknaghat where we meet with the Gram Pradhan and talk with him regarding this Awareness program. And with the enthusiasm of the members and the cooperation of the people this Awareness program was a success.





3. Awareness on Water Conservation (Jal Jeewan Mission): April 23, 2022:

On the occasion of "Earth Day" students of Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT) Waknaghat, Solan, organized a visit to a local government school named GSSS, under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) program. The motive of this visit was to educate children about -"How to save water & preserve our beautiful earth". On Saturday 23 April, we went to GSSS school & surveyed the school. While surveyed, most of the basic amenities in the school were proper & well maintained. We interacted with children about their knowledge over Environmental concerns & how to preserve our planet. The students were filled with zeal & enthusiasm, they responded wonderfully & gave a few amazing ideas. We explained to the children about rain water harvesting & " Swachh Bharat Mission ". We also counselled students about their future goals & their interests. Children found this session very useful & interesting. We had a very productive conversation with the school principal & teachers, where we discussed the talent within students & basic issues of a small village school. This visit was extremely successful & it will leave a deep impact in the society.







4. Participation in Gram Sabha under Chawsa and Dumehar Panchayat: May 01, 2022:

Under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) program students of Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT) Waknaghat, Solan, participated in Chawsha village Gramsabha on 1st of May. The students were provided with college bus for transportation. They reached chawsha village around 1:30 P.M. in the afternoon and gathered at the Gram Panchat office where they joined other local villagers for gram Sabha. During this visit 10 students along with their faculty coordinators Dr. Gopal Singh Bisht and Dr. Saurav attended the Gram Sabha. The key point of the day's discussion were issues related to Below Poverty Line Subsidy (BPL). The discussion was held to identify which individuals have not received benefits from the BPL schemes and also to distinguish who actually belonged to the BPL category. The faculty coordinator of UBA addressed the Gram Sabha regarding Water Conservation Awareness and further issues related to organic farming. The villagers showed great participation in this event and thus the visit was successful.







5. Richhana Visit to interact with villager about water issues: May 27, 2022

14. Computer Literacy programme for village students in JUIT: 14 January - 05 February, 2023

These interactive classes were held with one main goal of spreading the knowledge of computers to all the children of nearby villages (VILLAGE UNDER UBA). Eight such classes (12+ hours in total) have been successful with great response from children. The classes were held in the span of four weeks from 14th January,2023 to 5th February 2023. Basic topics were included in these sessions which included computer hardware, basic typing, file maintenance and organization MS-Word, MS-Excel, browsing the internet, email writing, privacy and license, computer troubleshooting etc. We received love, support, and great reviews from the students.

Our main purpose for conducting these classes is to give the basic knowledge about how Computer works and how Computer can bring people closer together using E-mail, Chatting, Videoconferencing and social media. It saves time, efforts and money compared with letters used, before evolution of computers in human life.
