Unnat Bharat Abhiyan was launched by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD). It is based on the premise to promote development of rural areas in tune with Gandhian vision of self-sufficient 'village republics' eco-friendly technologies so that the basic needs of food, clothing, shelter, sanitation, health care, energy, livelihood, transportation, and education are locally met.

The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. It also aims to create a virtuous cycle between society and an inclusive academic system by providing knowledge and practices for emerging professions and to upgrade the capabilities of both the public and the private sectors in responding to the development needs of rural India.

Institutes through their faculty and students, will carry out studies of living conditions in the adopted villages, assess the local problems and needs, workout the possibilities of leveraging the technological interventions and the need to improve the processes in implementation of various government schemes, prepare workable action plans for the selected villages. Such knowledge inputs would make their way into the development programs in rural areas. The Institutes would be expected to closely coordinate with the district administration, elected public representatives of panchayat / villages and other stakeholders and will become very much a part of the process of development planning and implementation

Theme: Child Health and cleanliness

The Wealth of a nation is not so much in its of economical and natural resources but it lies more decidedly in the kind and quality of the wealth of its children and youth. It is they who will be the creators and shapers of a nation's tomorrow. With the motive of overall development of children, this year the institution started the program of BAL-VIKAS which is spreading awareness to general public regarding child physical and mental health. Name of Activity: 'SAHAS' Making Women Self-Reliant

Theme: Women role in Nation-building

Need of the Activity

'SAHAS' Making Women Self-Reliant program works with women living in villages. By forming SHGs and collectives, they are provided knowledge and skills to save money, access micro credit, engage in income generating activities and become agents of change.

Women living in rural areas of Ariyavur Ukkadaiyavur village have little control over their lives or in decision making matters. Dependency on male members limits their own agency within the social and familial setting.

Dependency on male members of the family was observed in almost every sphere of their lives. In part, women's low status in the family and lack of decision-making was ascribed to her near total economic and social dependency on men.

The following activities are conducted in the program:

- Women role in nation- building
- Steps: Ideation to commercialization
- Business Under Rs.50,000/-
- Government scheme for women entrepreneurs

Activity:6 Program to address Child Malnutrition UBA initiative

Theme: Health- Basic Amenities

Students from the UBA Team of AIMAN College took a step forward towards a safe and healthy future by organizing a campaign on Child nutrition. The event was made possible with the valuable coordination of respected gram Pradhan Kids of the village were facing problems of malnutrition which made them an easy prey of common diseases because of low immunity. The major problem is the lack of awareness among the people. Through the Survey and interaction with the people of the village, the team realized that many people of the villagers are unaware of the various health policies offered by the government.

In order make them understand their food habits students prepared Charts & displayed & explained in detail. Therefore, the purpose of the event to make people educated about the basic nutrition needs of human body. The villagers were made aware about the eating habits and that their meals should contain nutrient-rich foods from each of the following food groups: proteins, fruits, vegetables, grain products, and milk and milk products. Protein-rich foods have the added advantage of containing iron and B vitamins.

Name of Activity: Teaching children about good and bad touch

Theme: Child Sexual Abuse

Need of the Activity

Considering the fact that cases of child sexual abuses are on the rise, an awareness session on 'Good Touch Bad Touch' was conducted through AIMAN UBA Team in Ariyavur Ukkadaiyavur. The students were made aware of what kind of behavior they should watch out among adults. They were also told about the body parts which no one should touch and in case somebody tries to touch them inappropriately, they should raise their voice and say 'NO'.

The students were told to reach out for help in case they sense any danger. They were made to list out the names that they trust the most. These names included their mother, teacher, father, somebody from neighborhood or some close relatives.

Some simple activities were conducted with the children so that they are able to relate themselves with what they were taught. The session helped the children shed their inhibitions and reservations linked with the topic of sexual abuse.
