The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is a government scheme in India that aims to promote the comprehensive development of rural areas by fostering participatory and sustainable growth. It involves the adoption of villages by educational institutions, which work towards improving the socio-economic conditions of the community.

In this context, the Foods and Nutrition Department conducted an activity in the adopted village of Sihol on 2nd May 2023.
