The theme, Organic Farming has been reinforced by UBA Cell of Bon Secours College for Women, Thanjavur and meet the farmers regularly and offers expertise.



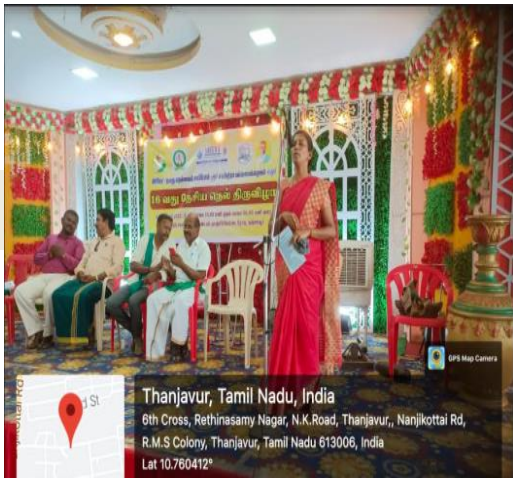
