ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

It gives me immense pleasure to present unto you the annual report of the Patrician village adoption program under the flagship of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. It is right and just to begin this annual report by thanking the management for their tremendous support and guidance.

This report is the reflection of the extra mile that our faculty and students have put forth to bring about a change in the adopted villages.

The Patrician village adoption program was grandly inaugurated on the 23rd July 2022 by Tmt.G.Jayalakshmi Additional Director, Directorate of Social Welfare, Tamil Nadu.

The UBA Village adoption programme started with a workshop on PRA techniques. The UBA class coordinators were given training on participatory rural appraisal which included detailed understanding in Transect walk, Social Mapping VENN diagram, Problem Tree Analysis, Focus Group discussion and social survey.

Each village undertook household surveys and village surveys in their respective adopted villages for a period of 3 months. During these surveys they understood various the demographic details of the community, infrastructure facilities of the communities and the problems and concerns of the people. The students were trained in the participatory rural appraisal techniques to find out the challenges faced by the people in the community.

The care and share program during the month of Christmas was celebrated in all the villages on 16th December 2023 by spreading the message of care and share among the community. Various cultural events and games were organised by the students for the community children, women, youth and elderly. Winners were given prizes and Santa Claus distributed sweets to the children.

On 26th January 2023, the UBA team participated in the Republic Day celebrations with the community, and attended the Gram Sabha meeting to understand the concerns of the people and they stakeholders. UBA coordinators and students from our college participated in the Republic day events in the community.

Various awareness programs were conducted in the adopted villages to impart the knowledge and understanding about the social issues in the community.

An awareness program on the importance of girl child education and gender equity was conducted on 26th January 2023 with a community pledge to safeguard the rights of the girl child.

An awareness program on road safety to highlight the effects of rash driving and accidents was staged through a mime by our students in Uthandi village on 2nd March 2023.

On 21st February 2023 A dental camp was organised for the school children in Alandur village in collaboration with Saveeta Dental College.

An awareness program was conducted on 4th March 2023 in Navalur for the youth to inculcate the importance of sports and education.

A door to door awareness program on menstrual hygiene was organised in Navalur Village on 4th March 2023 to promote health and hygiene among the adolescent girls.

With the validation ceremony on 9th march 2023, the UBA programs for the year 2022-2023 was successfully ended. The journey has just begun and the patrician village adoption program has miles to go, to see the change that we foresee in our vision. And I am sure that with this commitment and dedication we can bring about a change in the lives of millions of people and transform the world.

Activity: First Transect Walk in Navallur Village

Date: 05/09/2022 @ 2:00 pm

Objective:

To observe, describe and show the location and distribution of resources, features, landscape.

Report

As a part of the transect walk two faculty members and two third year students from the Department of Computer Applications(Shift 1) went for a transect walk inside the village and met the local people. With the help of School Children, we met the **Panchayat Middle School Vice Principal** and Spoke to the School Principal over the phone.

We got the details of the Panchayat head and the meeting with the Panchayat head will be scheduled in the coming weeks.

Observation in the Middle school

There was no proper shelter for the children to have their Mid Mad Meal. So they had to sit in the hot sun to have their lunch. In the existing tent, only 200 students are able to occupy it. They require additional tents as there are 460 students in the school.

No proper benches were available for all the students, so many were sitting on the floor. They require mats for those students

Observation in Navallur village Panchayat during transect walk

- There is no connecting Bridge from Uthandi, ECR, and Navallur.
- So many students and all the local people travel 12 km which takes 40 min.
- There is a proposal to construct a bridge so that they can travel in 10 minutes

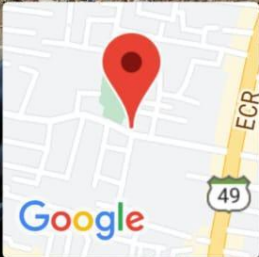


HOUSE HOLD SURVEY AND VILLAGE SURVEY



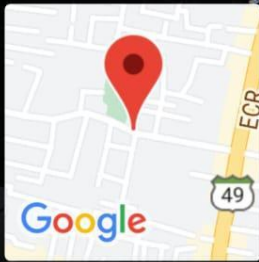

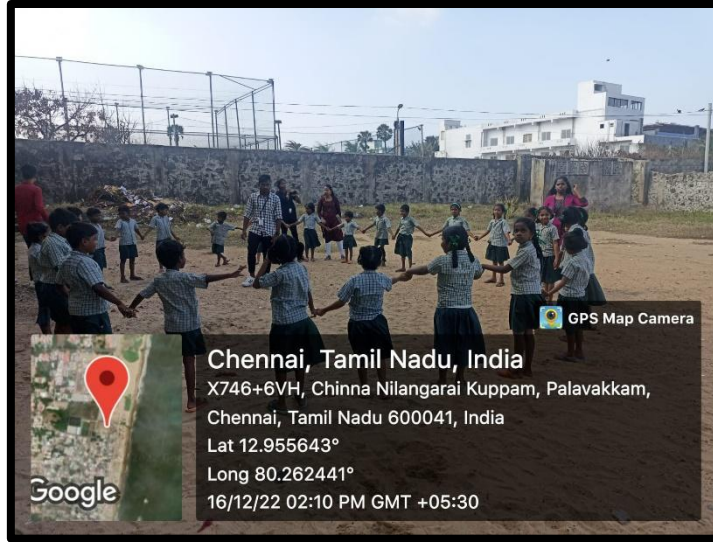
Programme Summary

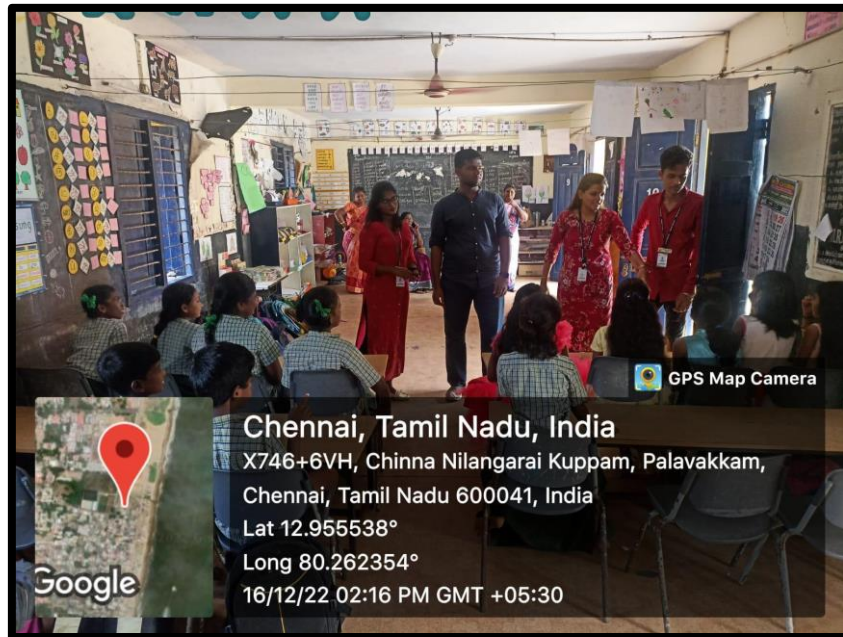
